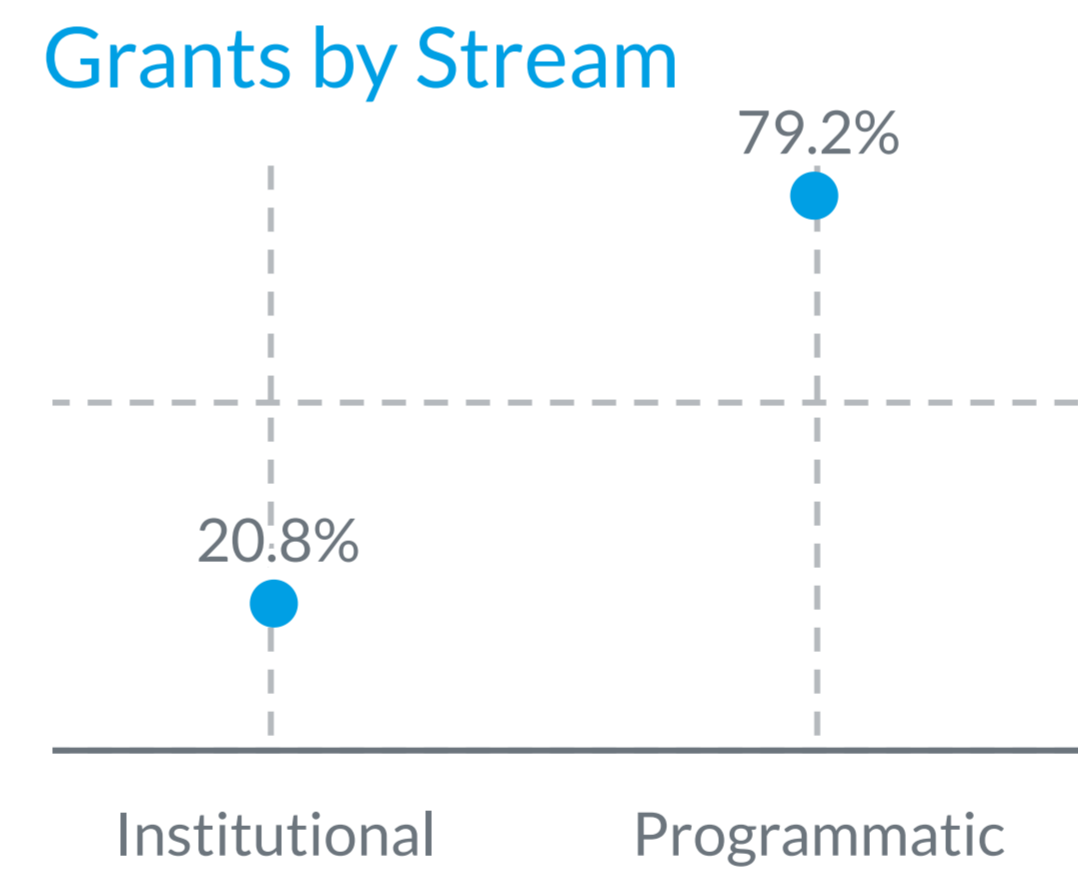

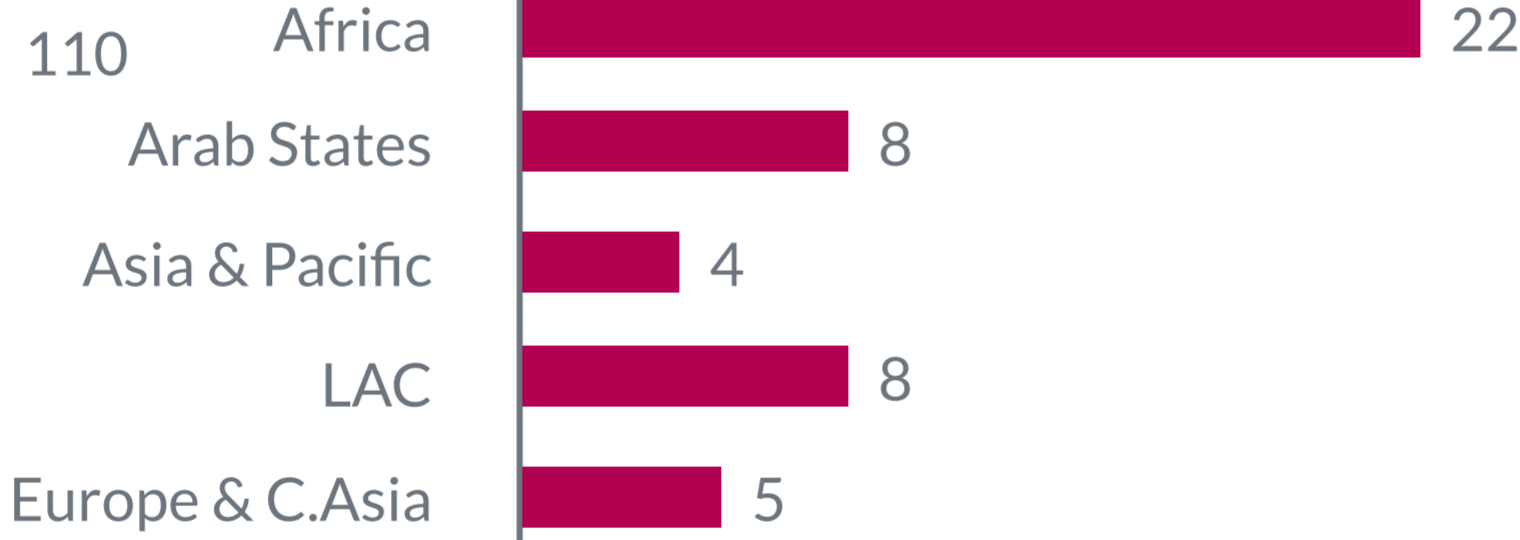
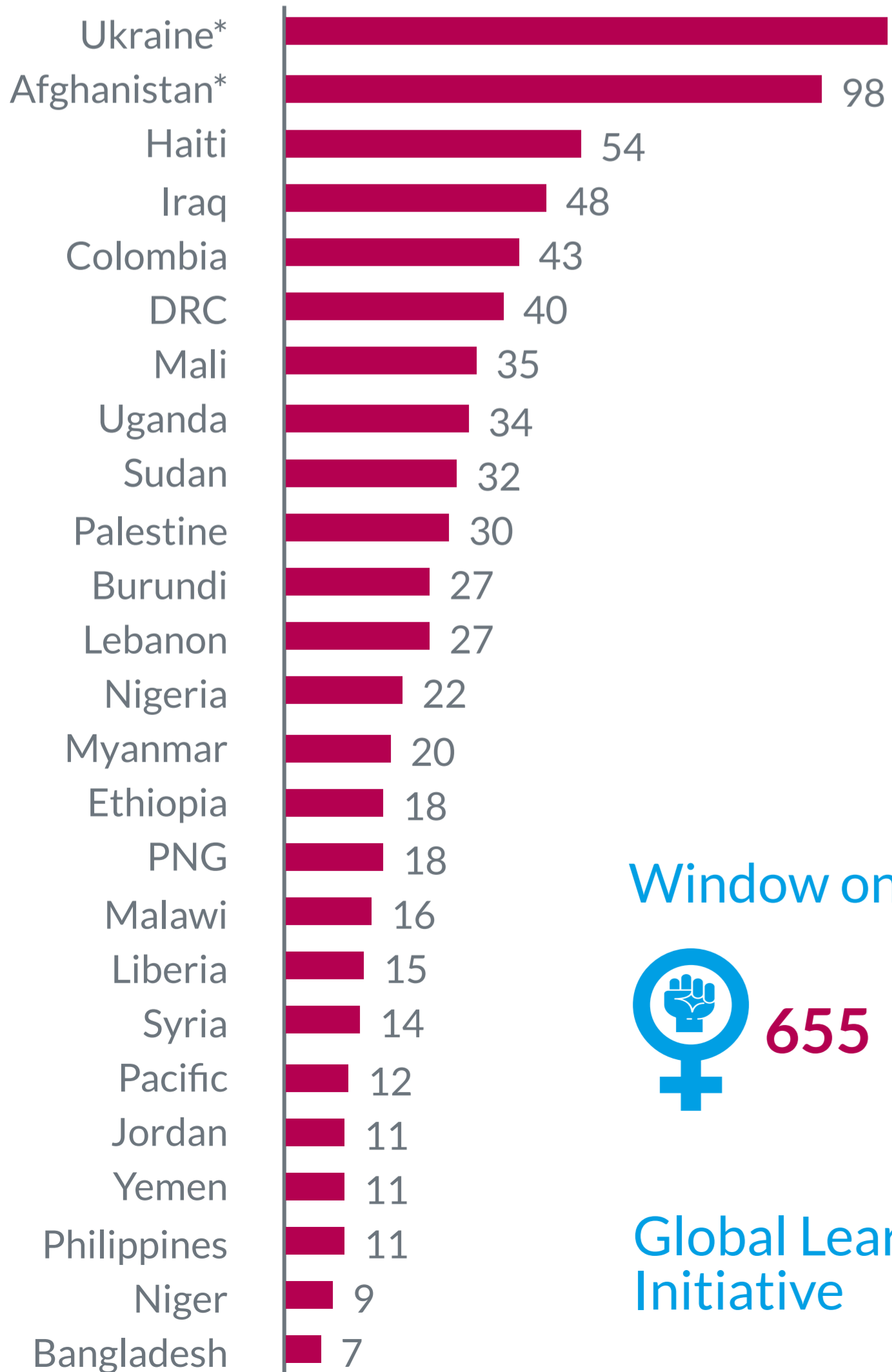
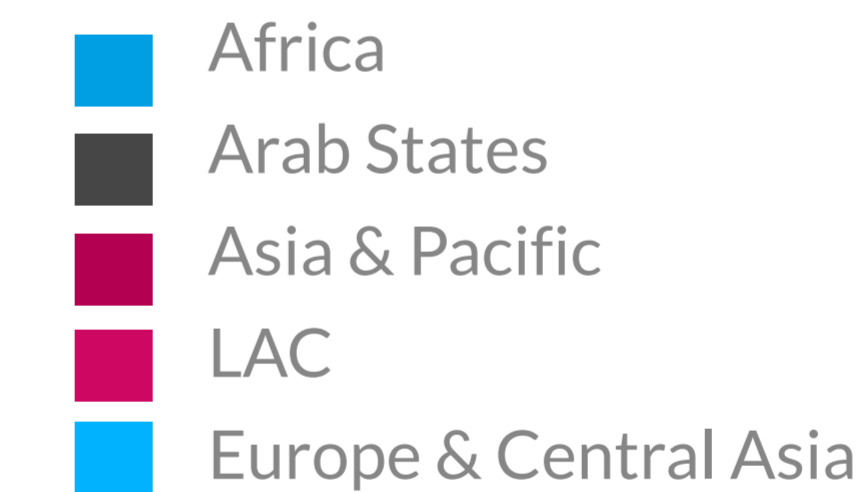

### Rapid Response Window (47)

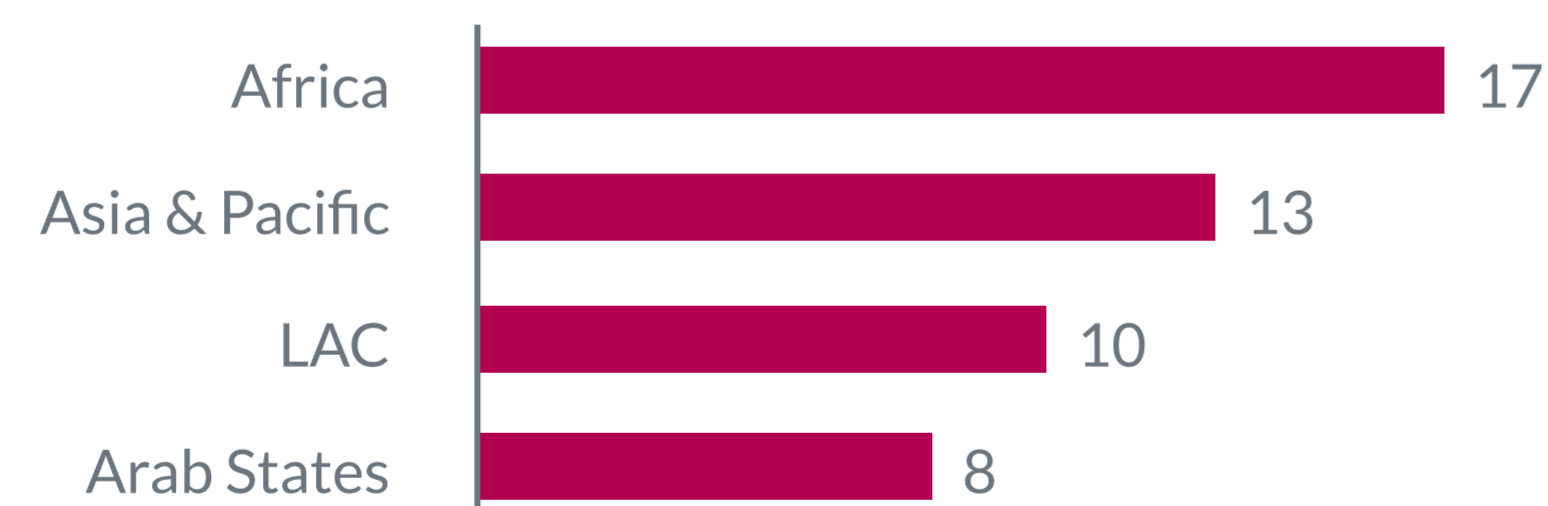


### Allocated Funds by Region

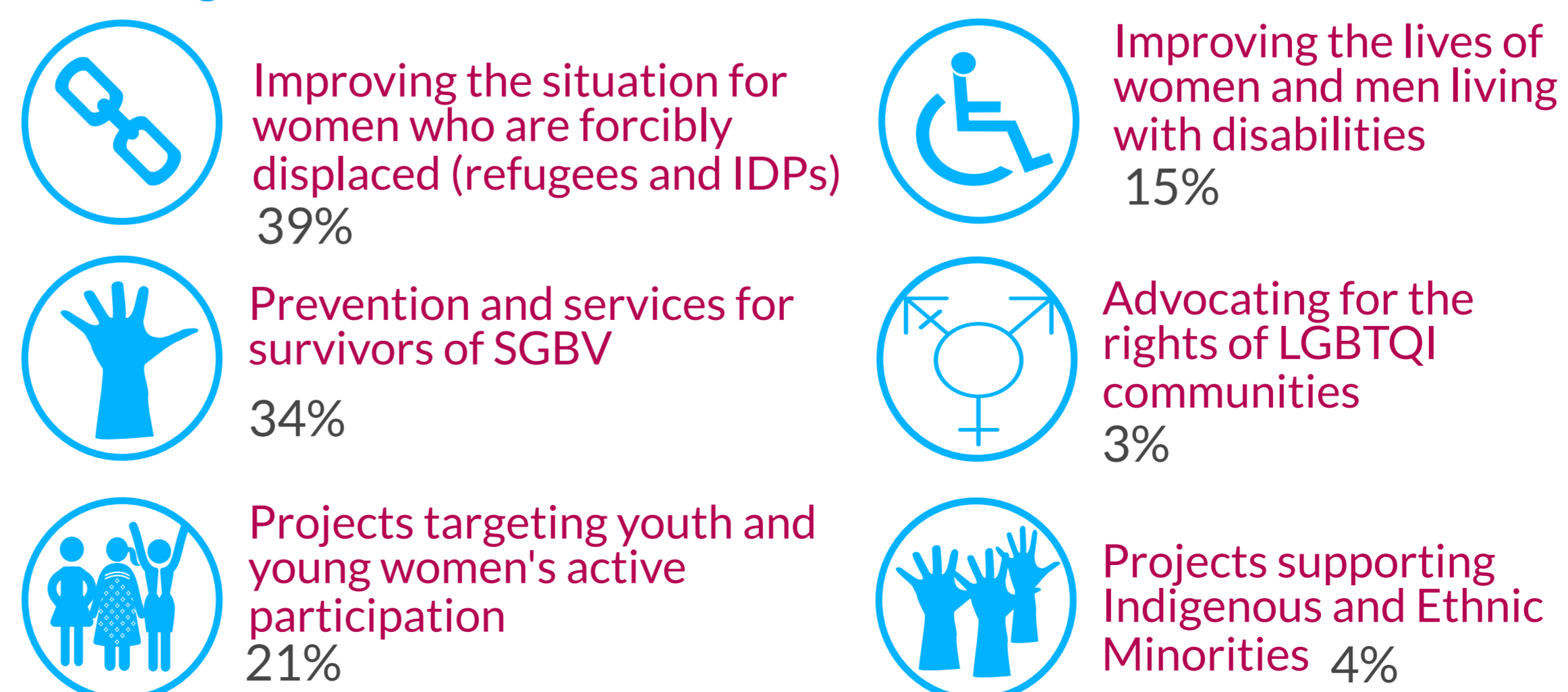
