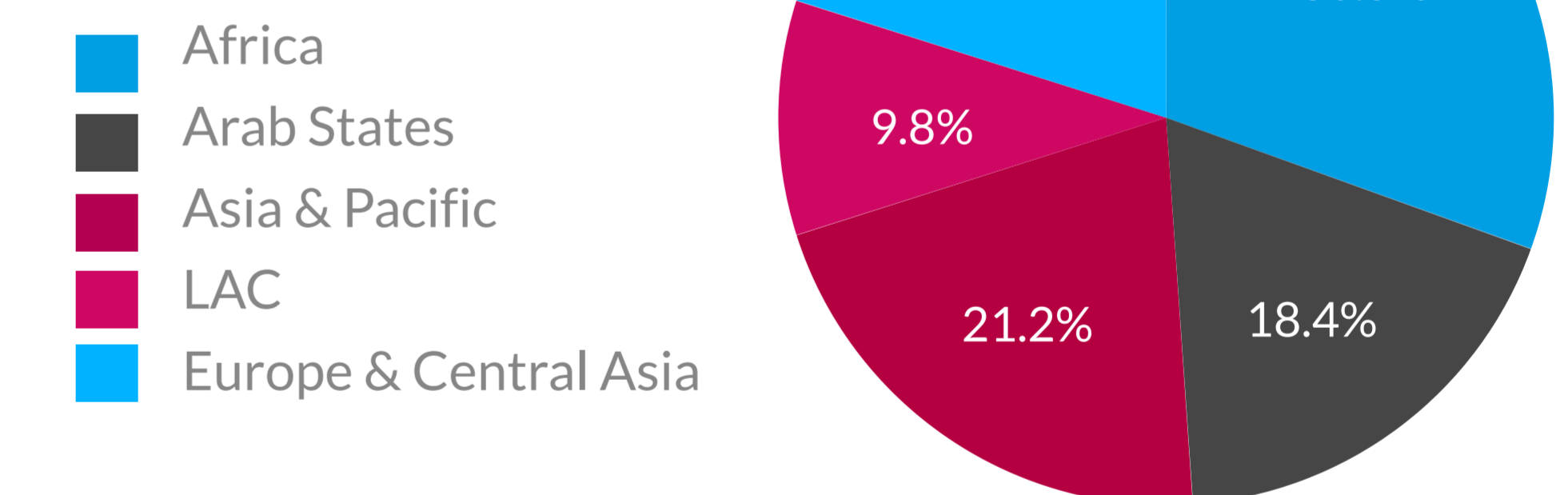
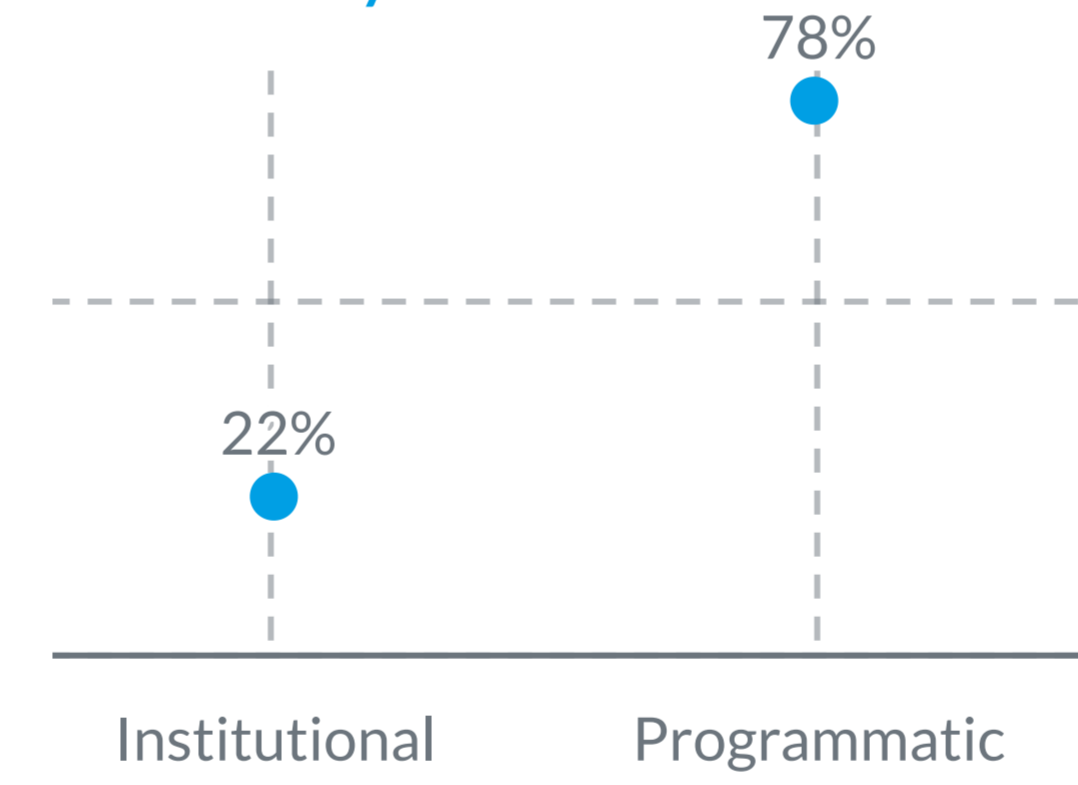

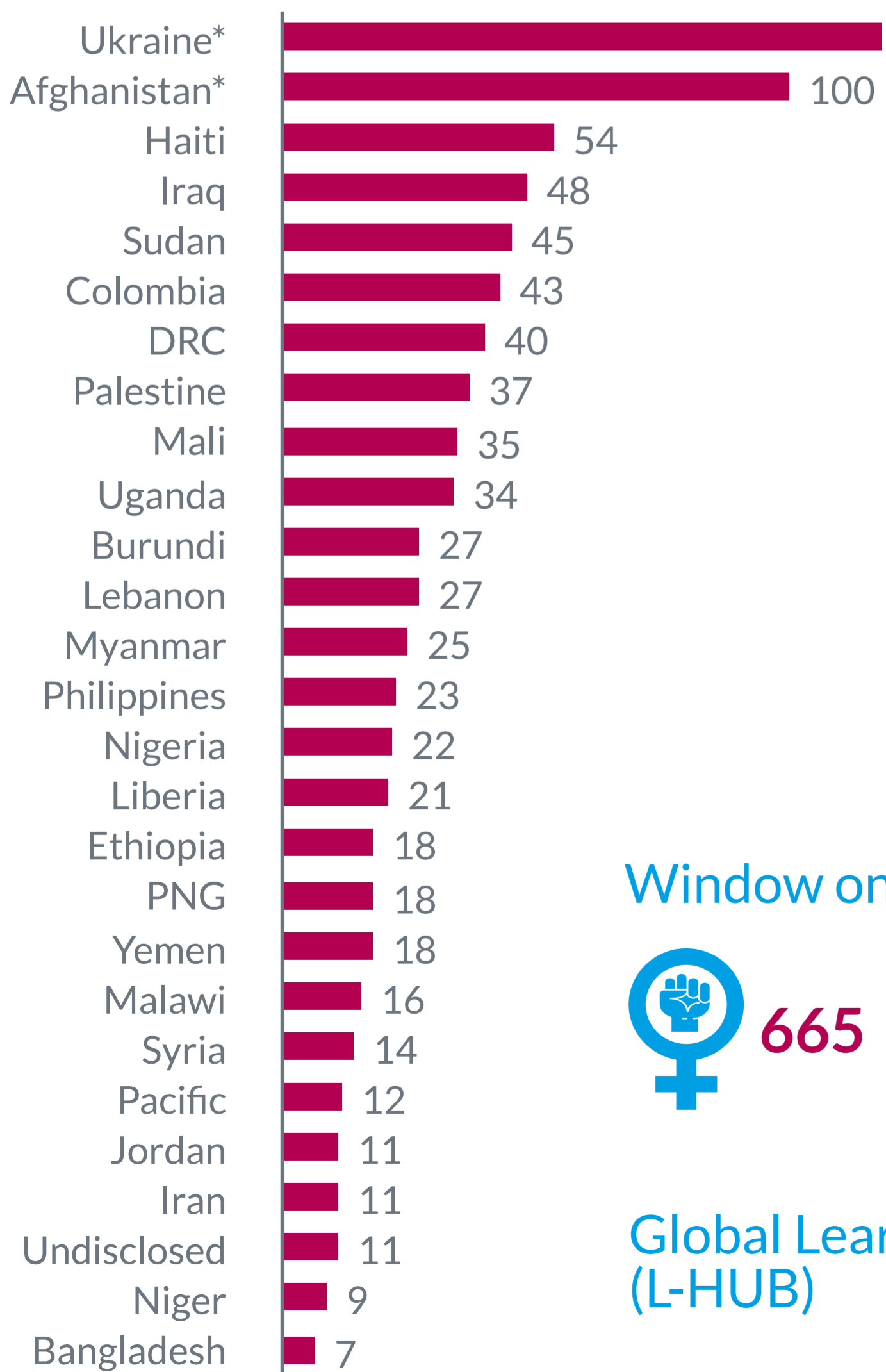

### Rapid Response Window (51)

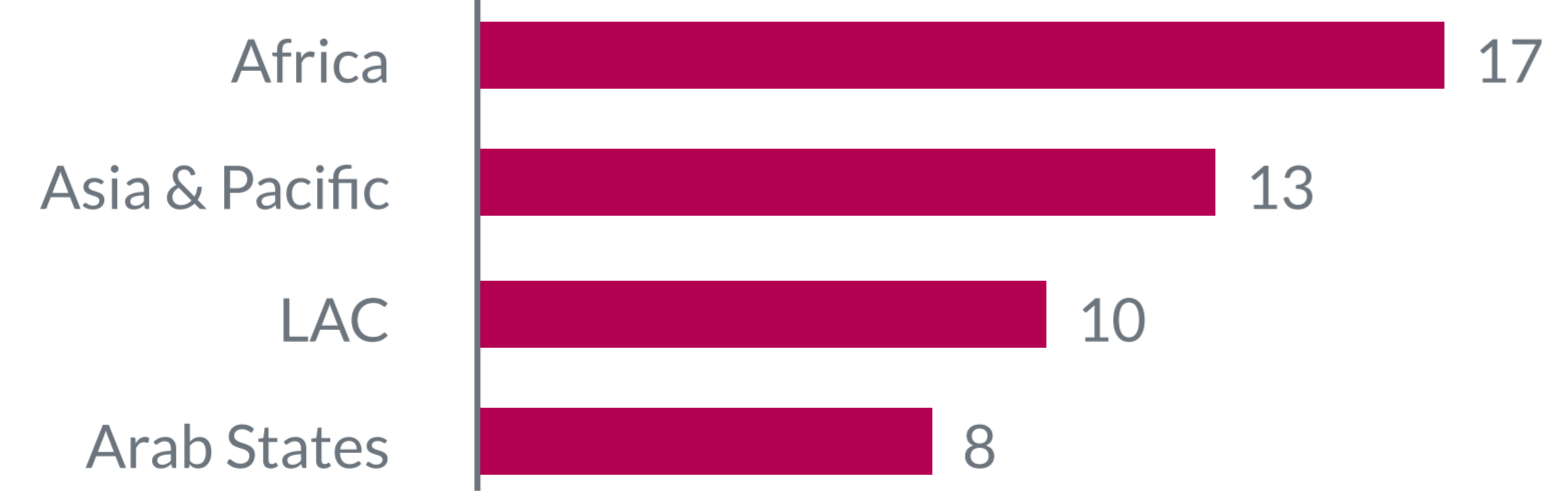
### Grants by Stream
