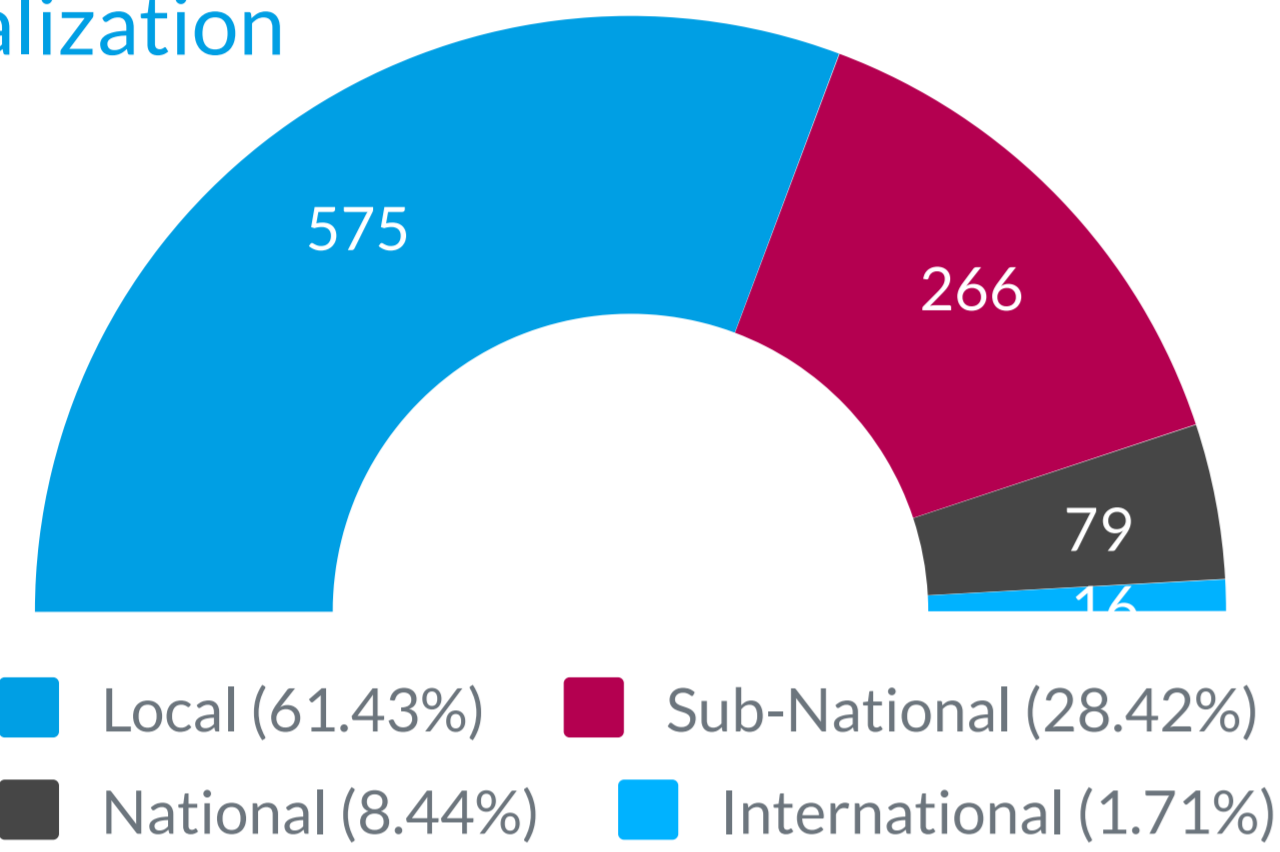


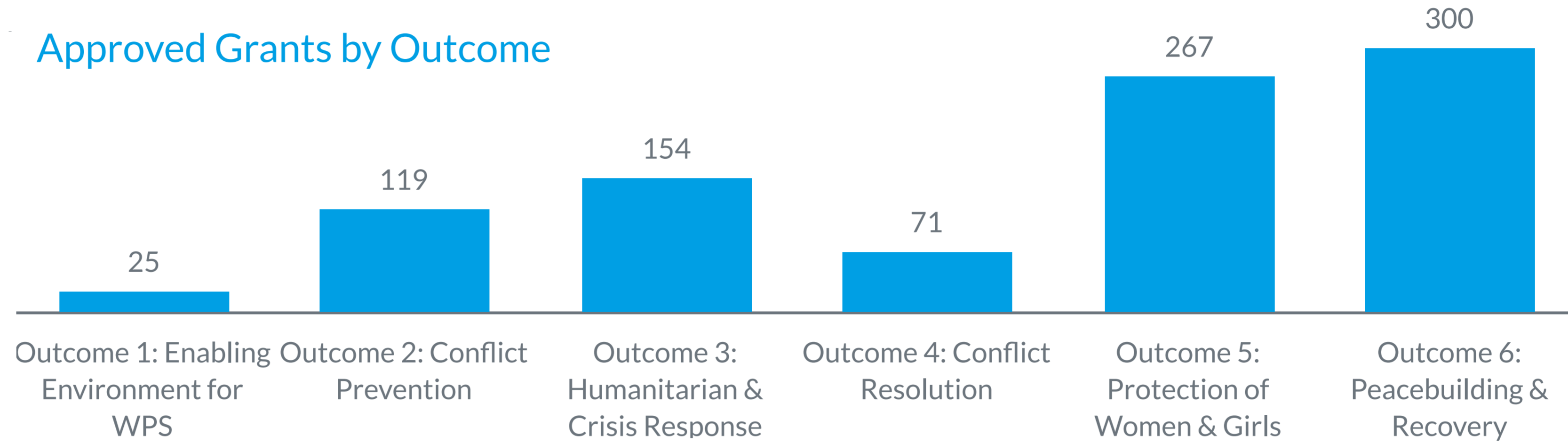

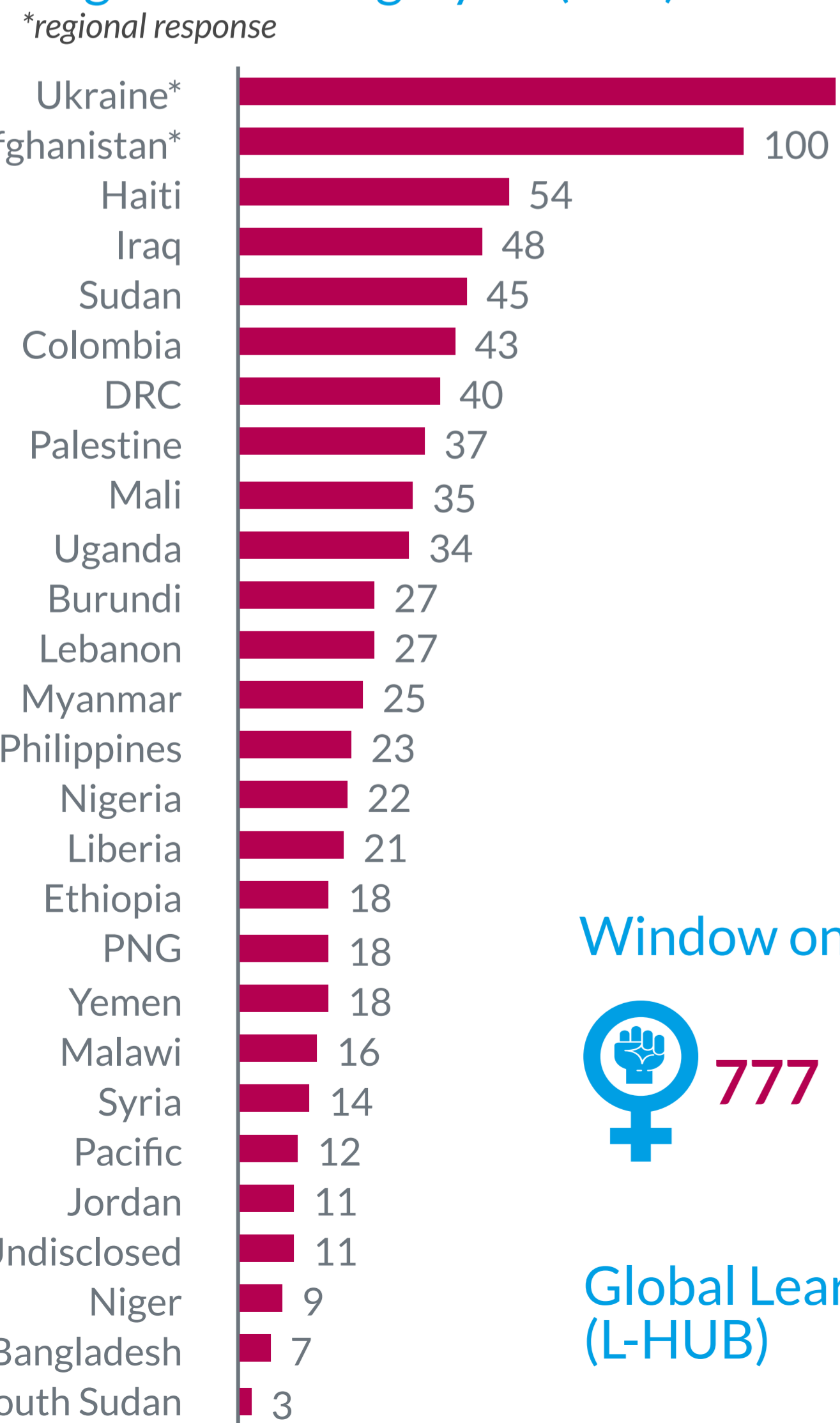
Approved Grants by Outcome



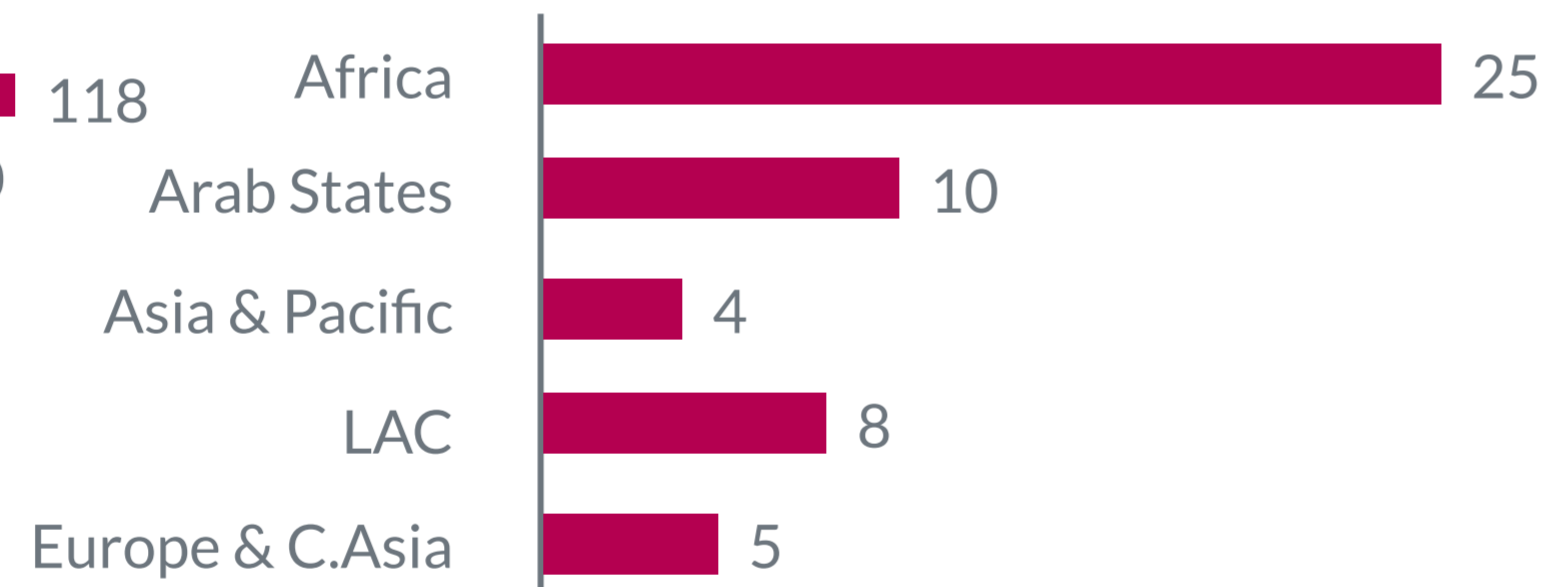
CSOs Led by a Forcibly Displaced Person

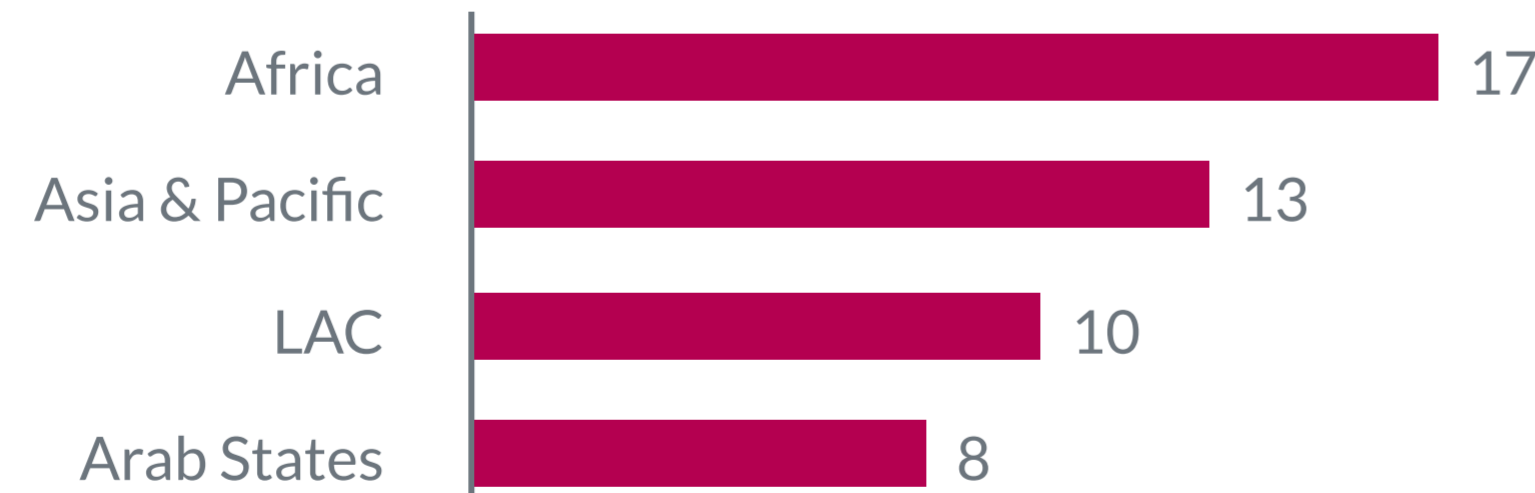
Regular Funding Cycle (836)

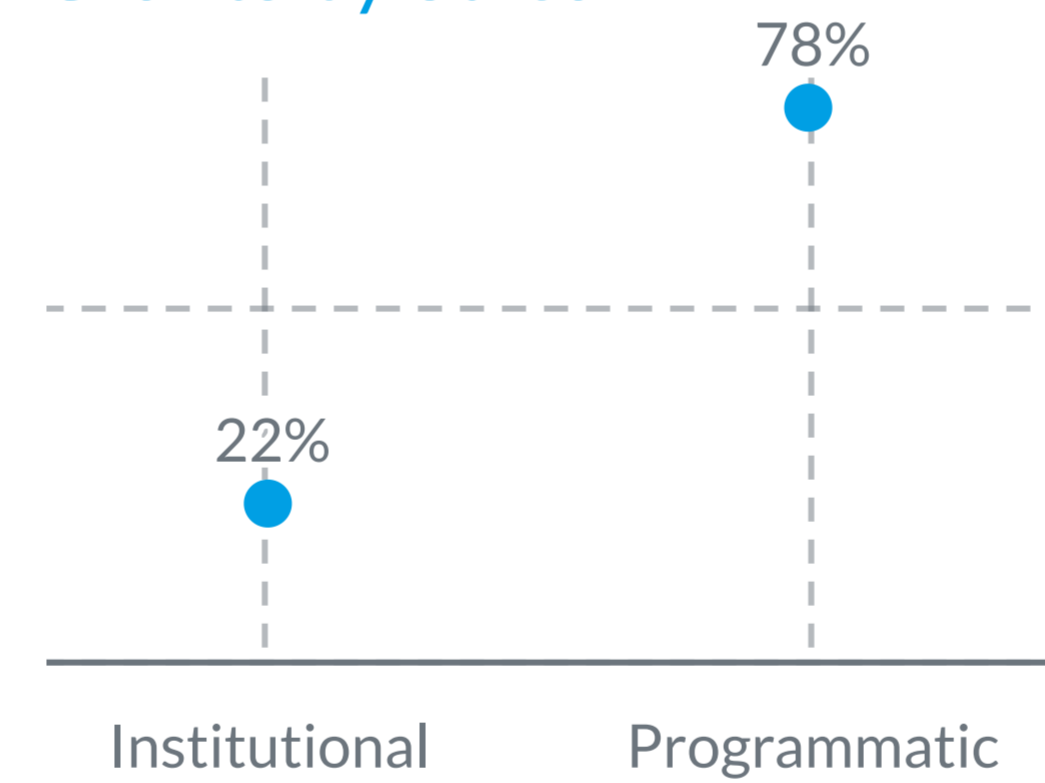

72% CSOs who have attended at least one webinar

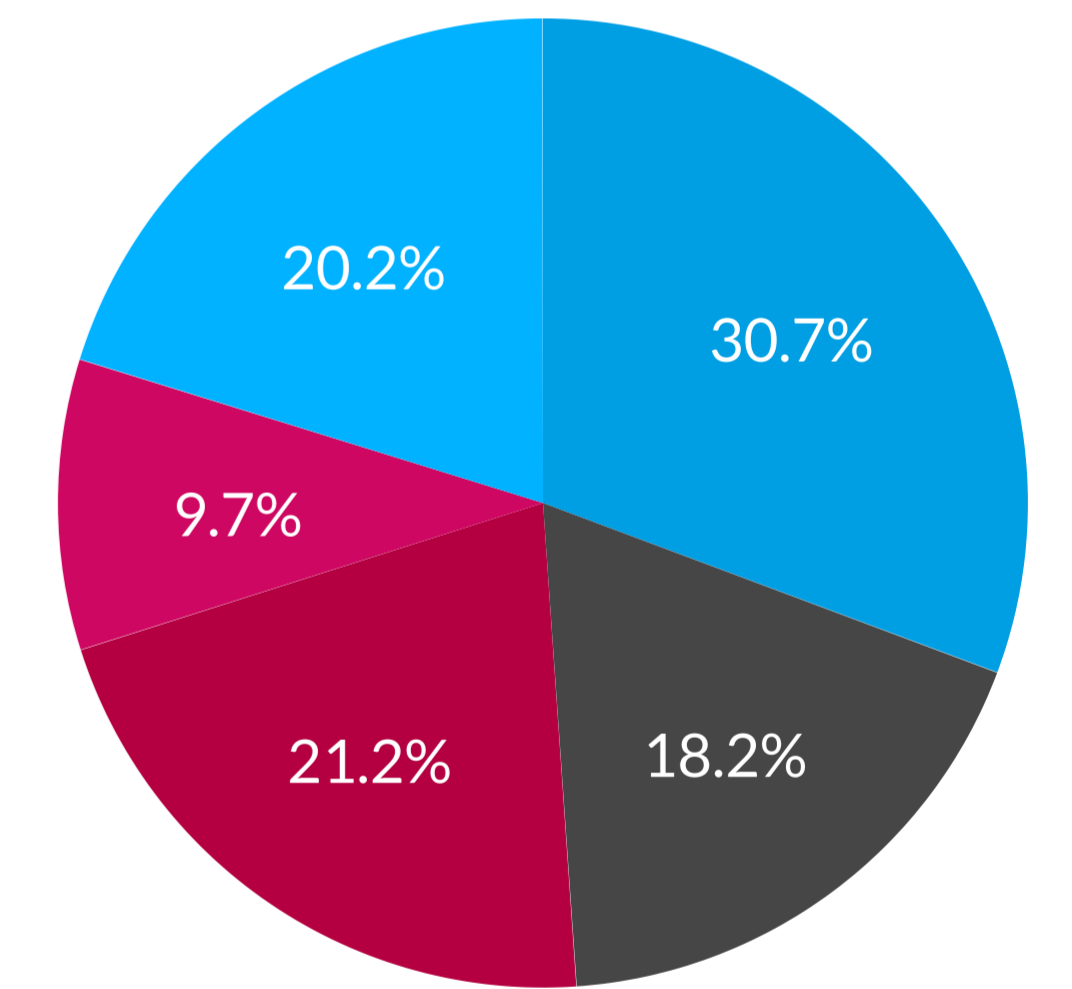
Grants by Stream
