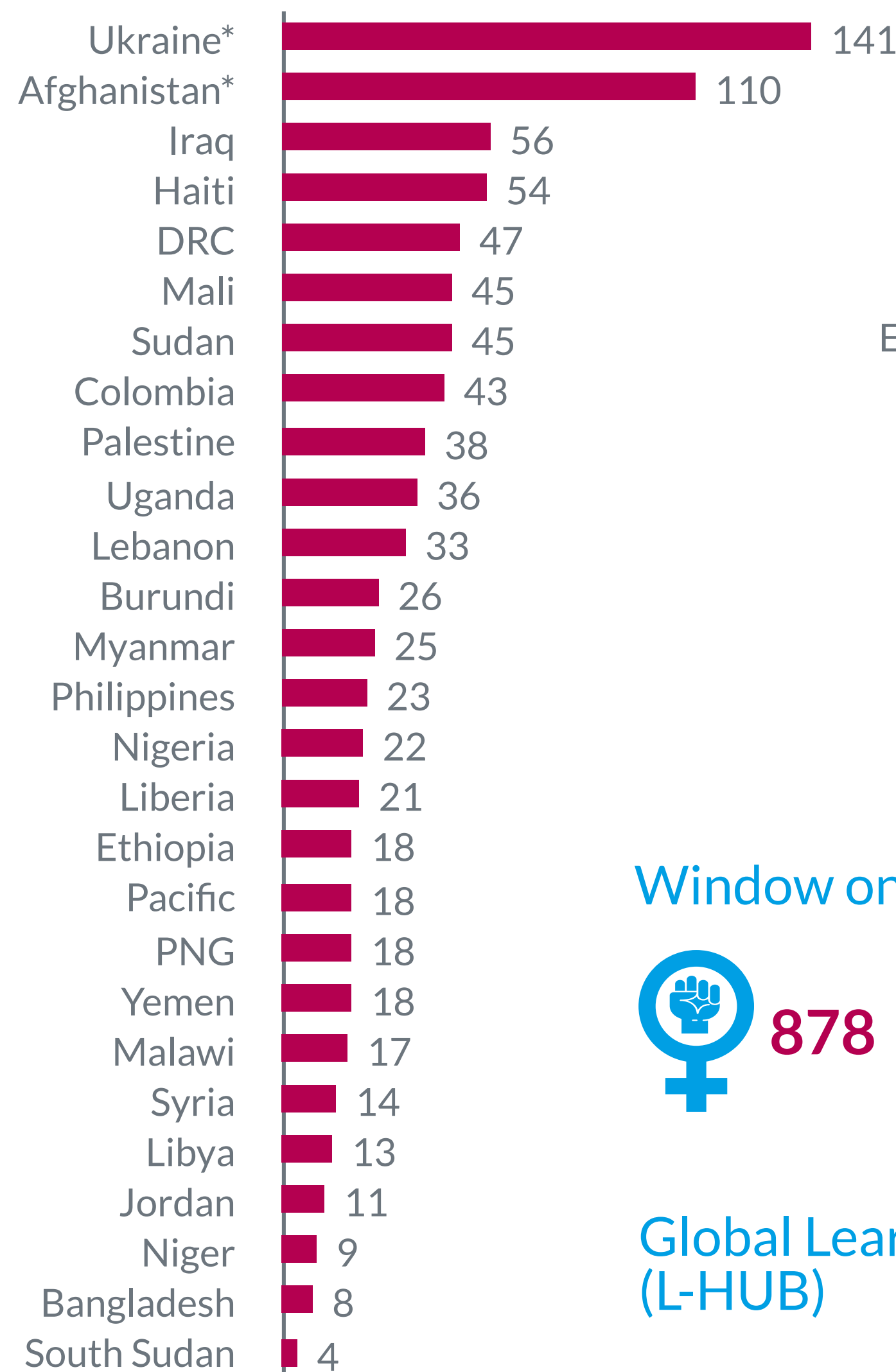

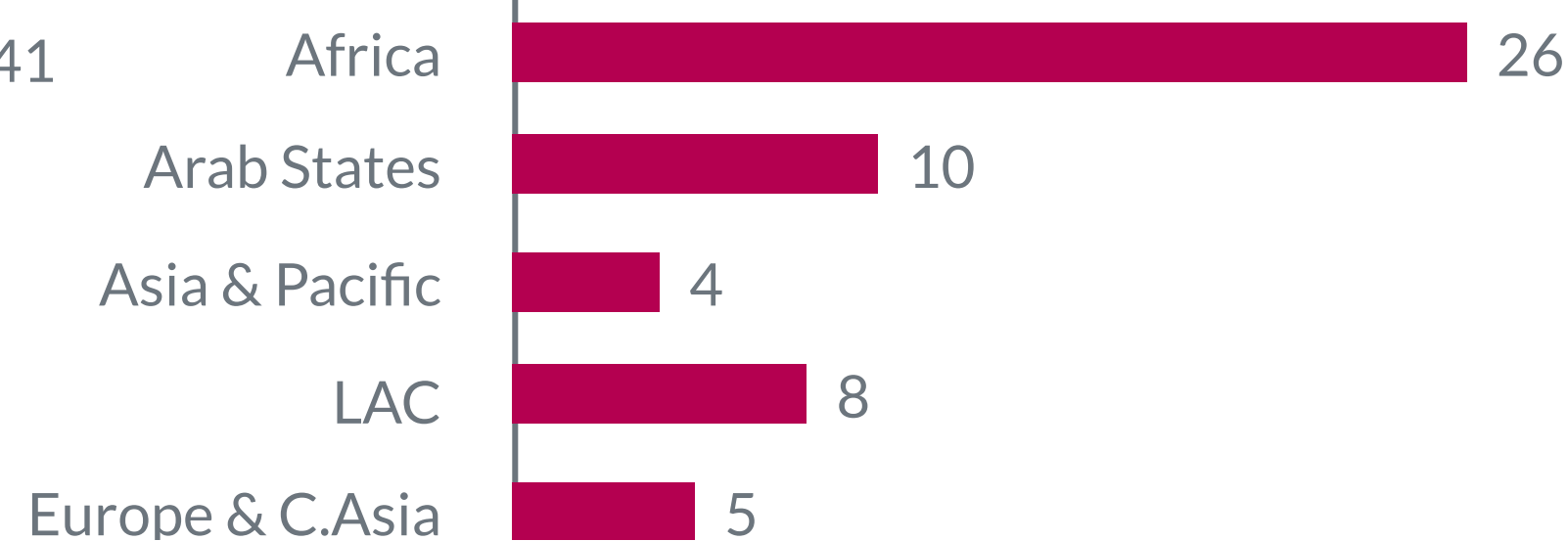

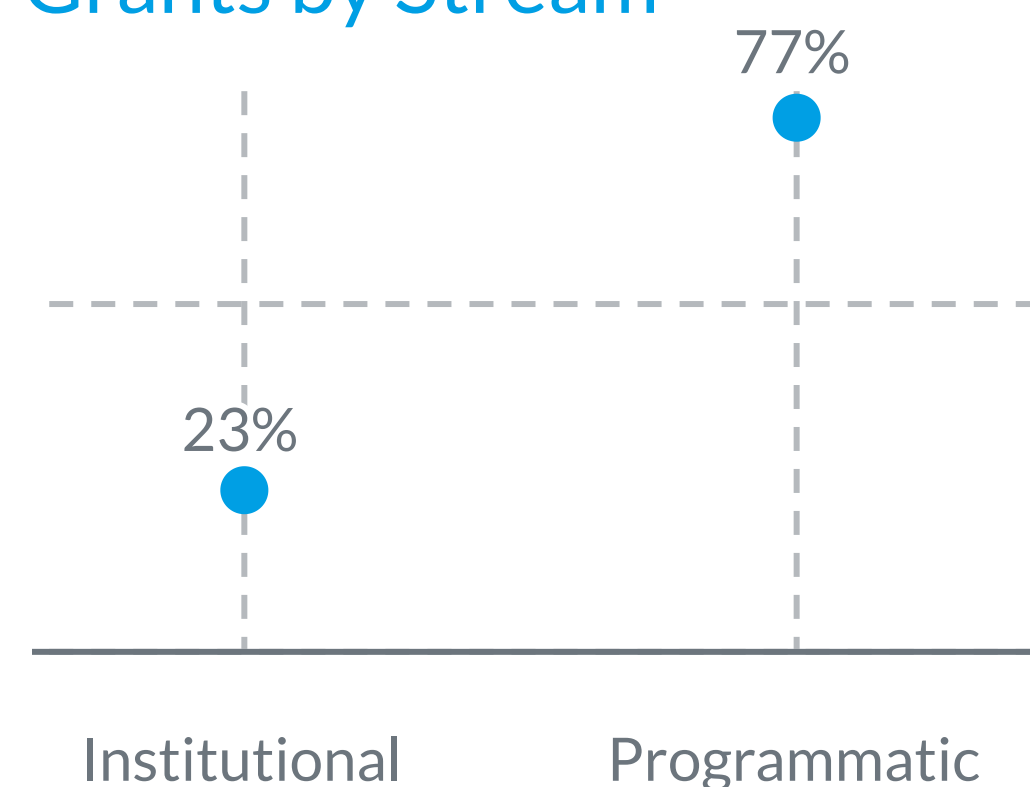

## Grants by Stream

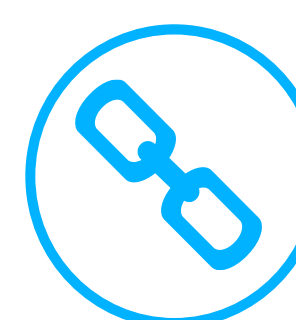


## Allocated Funds by Region

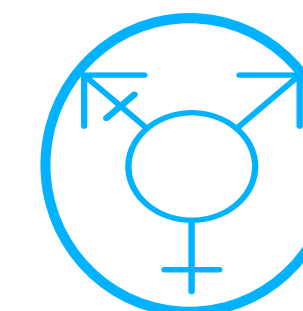
