


INTRODUCING THE WPHF PEACE IS GLOBAL CAMPAIGN

Peace Is a new campaign codesigned by the United Nations Women's Peace and Humanitarian Fund (WPHF), together with its partners, to reinforce peace—not just as the absence of war, but as the **active presence of justice**, **accountability**, **feminist leadership**, **and collective action**.

Through strategic policy advocacy, storytelling rooted in grassroots realities, dynamic public engagement, and powerful global partnerships, the Peace Is campaign bridges historic milestones with the present.

The Peace Is campaign seeks to amplify and elevate the voices of those on the frontlines. From war zones and refugee camps to protest lines and peace tables, it is often women, alongside their communities and allies, who are advancing peace and shaping solutions where they are needed most. WHO WE ARE

The United Nations Women's Peace and Humanitarian Fund (WPHF) is the only UN funding mechanism exclusively dedicated to supporting local, grassroots women's civil society organizations on the frontlines of crisis and conflict. As a flexible and rapid financing instrument, WPHF delivers both programmatic and institutional support to women peacebuilders, humanitarians, and human rights defenders in fragile settings around the world.

WPHF was established in 2016 in response to years of persistent advocacy by global civil society to operationalize the Women, Peace and Security (WPS) agenda—not through rhetoric, but by mobilizing flexible resources directly to the women most affected by crises and best positioned to build peace and drive recovery in their communities.

What makes WPHF unique is not only whom it funds but how it functions. Civil society organizations (CSOs) are not only recipients of funding; they are at the center of the Fund's decision-making structures:



At the global level, CSOs are represented on the WPHF Funding Board, alongside four UN entities and the Fund's four largest donors.



At the country level, CSOs help guide funding decisions through their participation in National Steering **Committees**, which select projects for support.

With this multilevel, decentralized governance model, WPHF demonstrates innovations within the UN System of a more feminist approach to financing: one that is flexible, accessible, inclusive, and accountable to the women and communities it serves. Central to this model is the expertise of CSOs, which informs not only WPHF's funding decisions but also its capacity development and networking initiatives. Through its Global Learning Hub (L-HUB), a space shaped by and for CSOs, WPHF facilitates peer learning, knowledge sharing, and professional development opportunities for all supported partners.

To turn this feminist model into impact, WPHF delivers resources through three targeted funding mechanisms designed to meet the urgent and long-term needs of local women's organizations:

THE RAPID RESPONSE WINDOW (RRW) providing fast, targeted providing vital resources

support for women's direct participation in peace and political processes, from highlevel negotiations to community-led dialogues.

THE WOMEN HUMAN **RIGHTS DEFENDERS** (WHRDS) WINDOW

to protect and support women peacebuilders, humanitarian responders, and human rights activists in dangerous contexts, enabling them to continue their advocacy and activism in times of crisis.

THE REGULAR **FUNDING CYCLE**

providing flexible, institutional, and programmatic funding to local civil society organizations advancing women's leadership in peacebuilding, crisis response, and humanitarian action.
