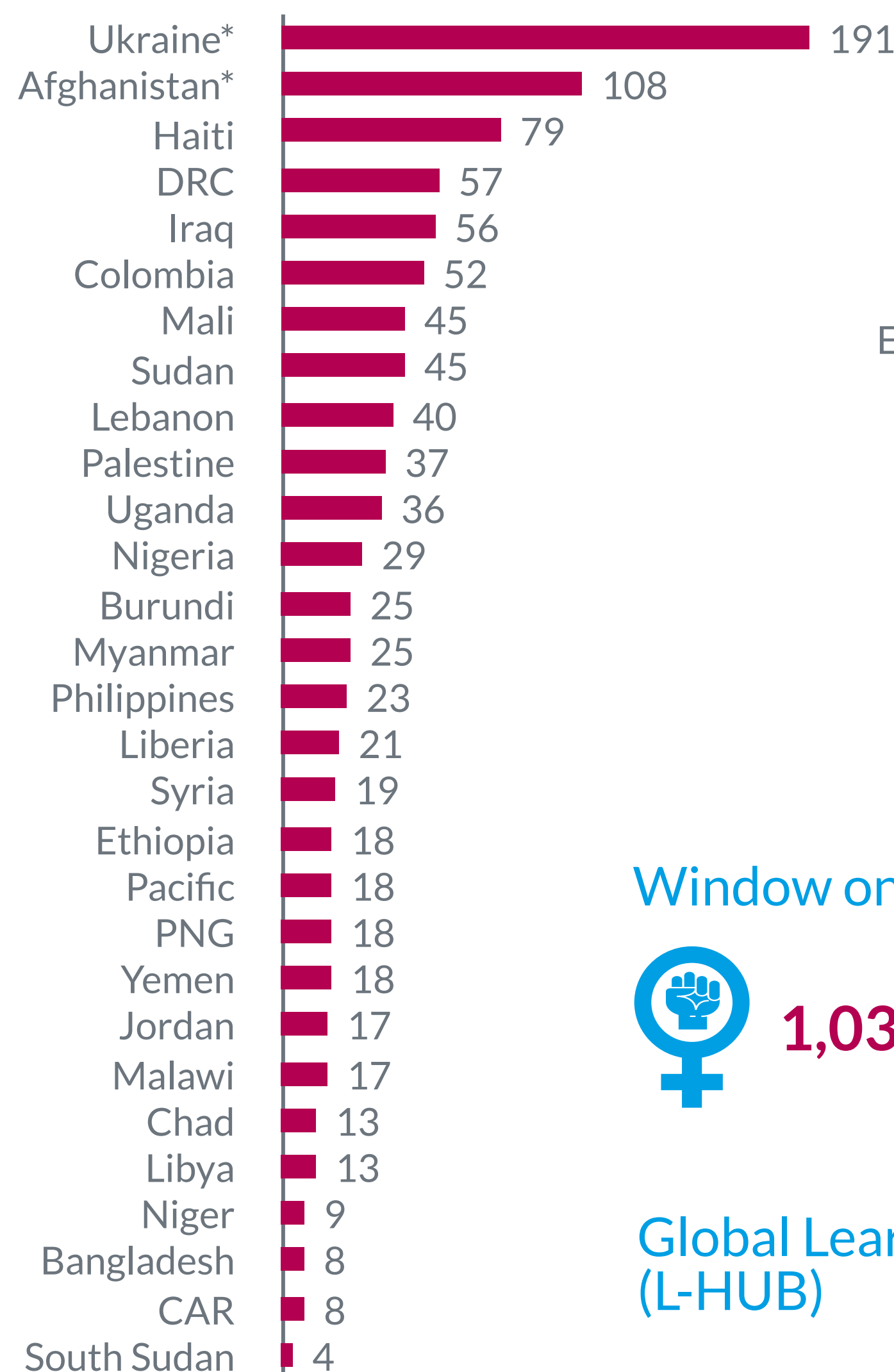

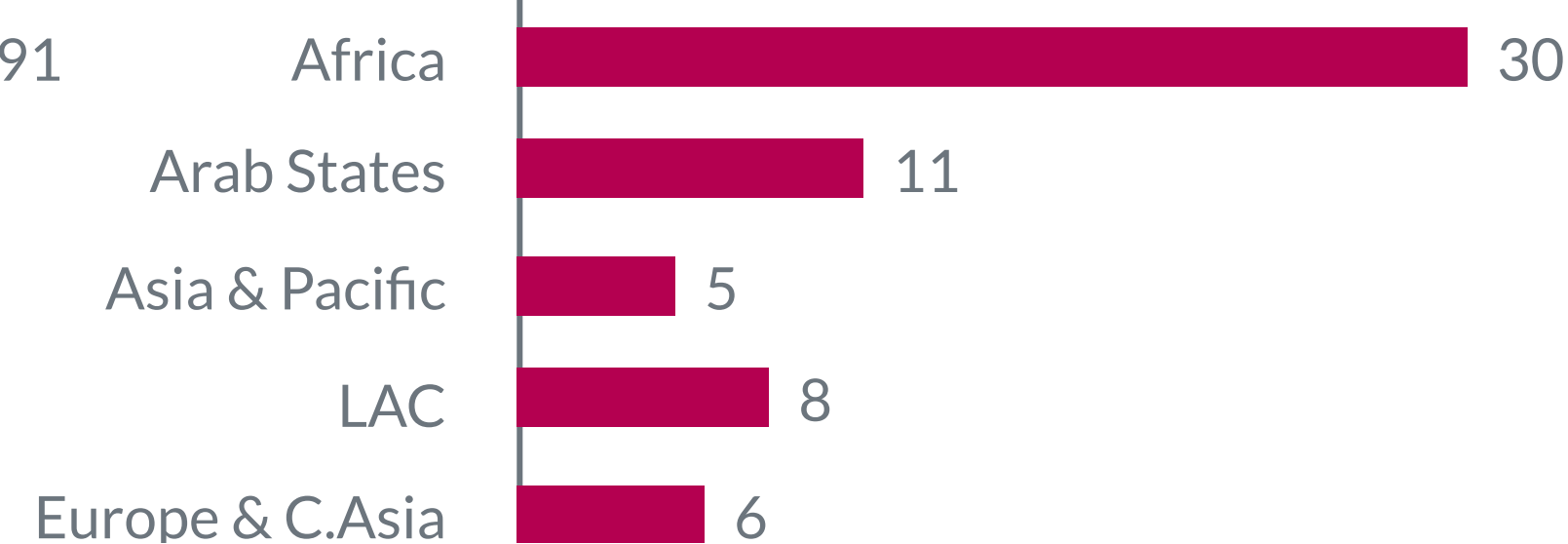

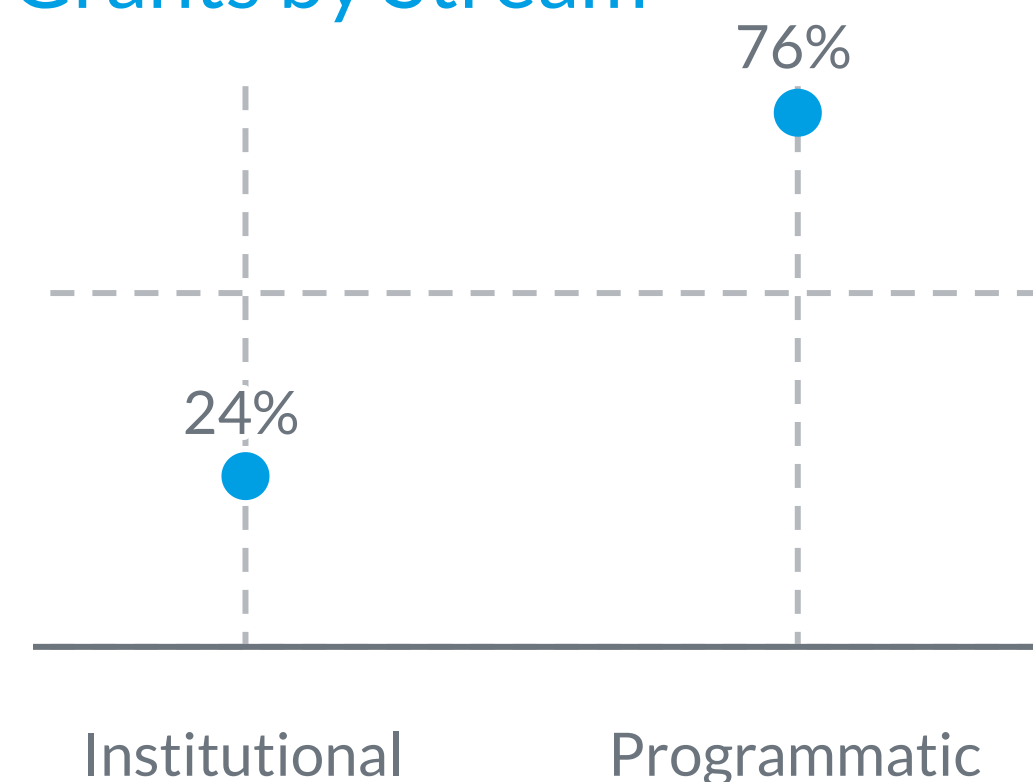

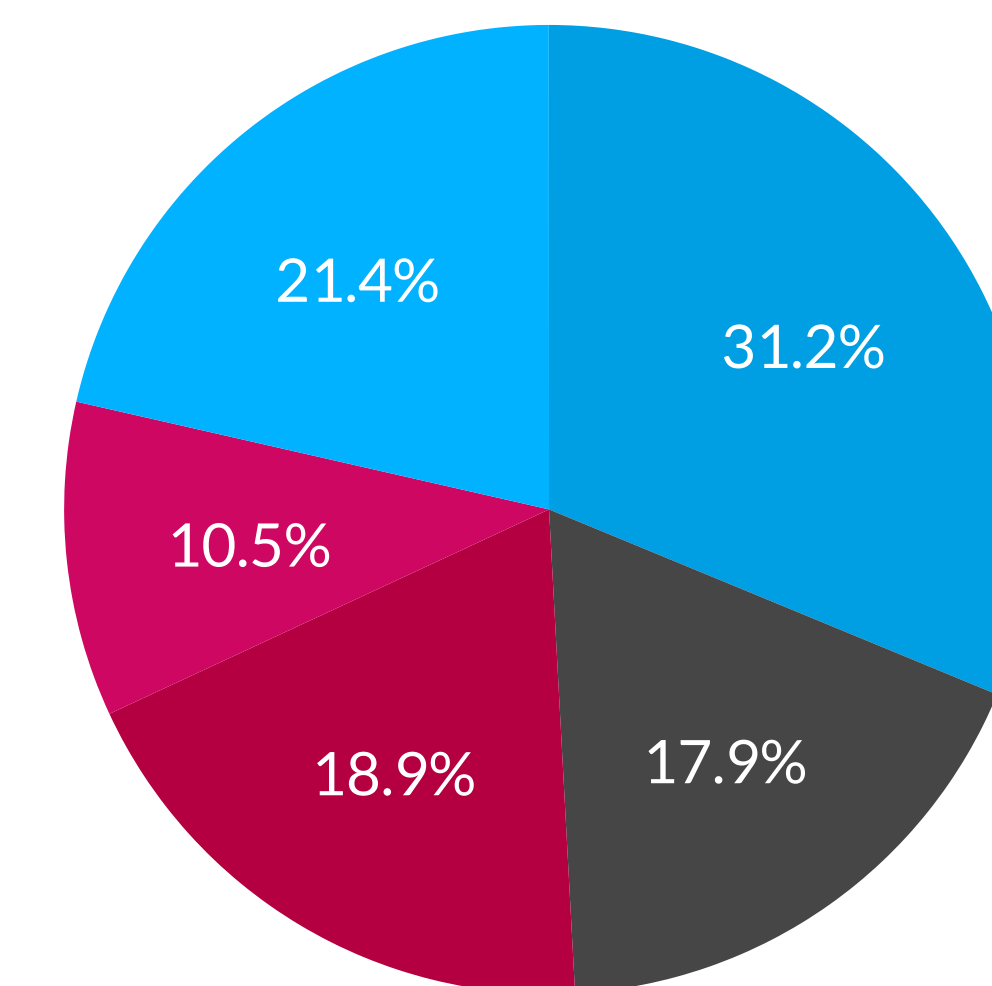

### Grants by Stream

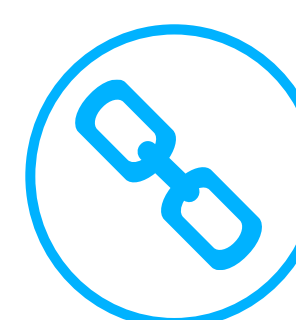


### Allocated Funds by Region

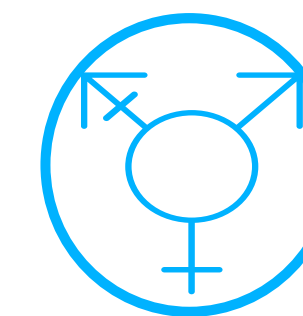
