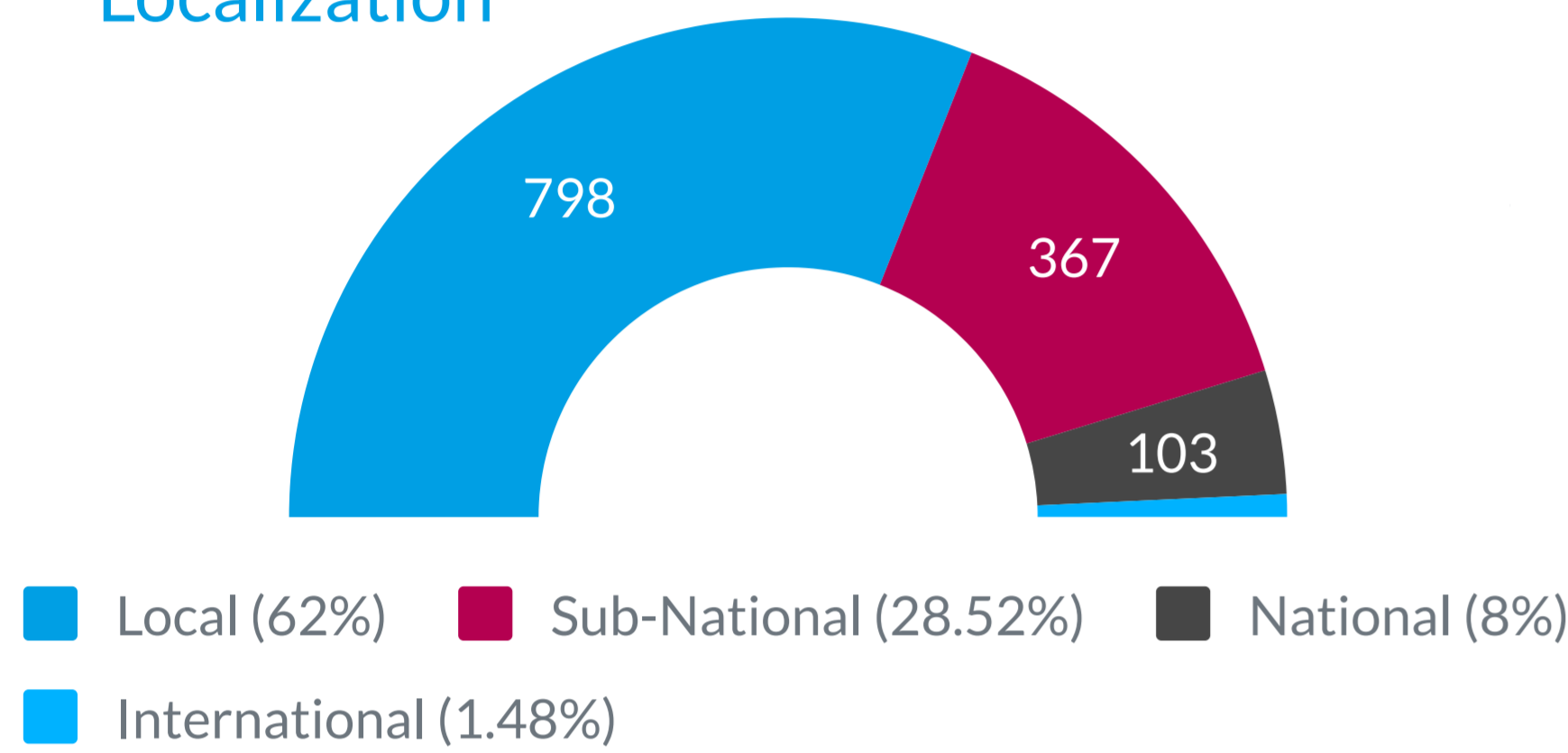


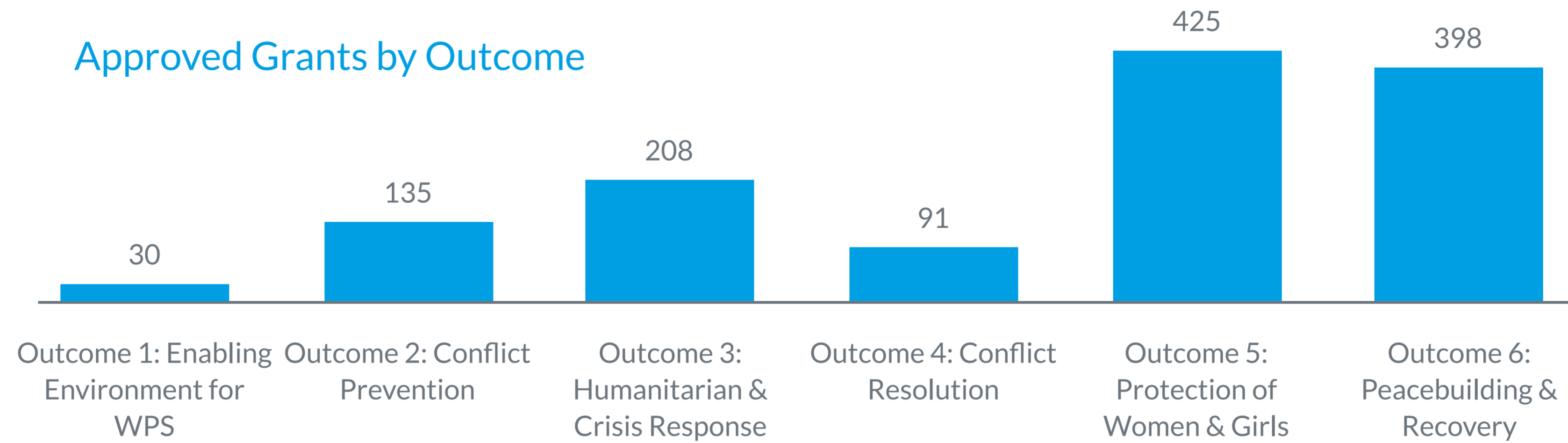

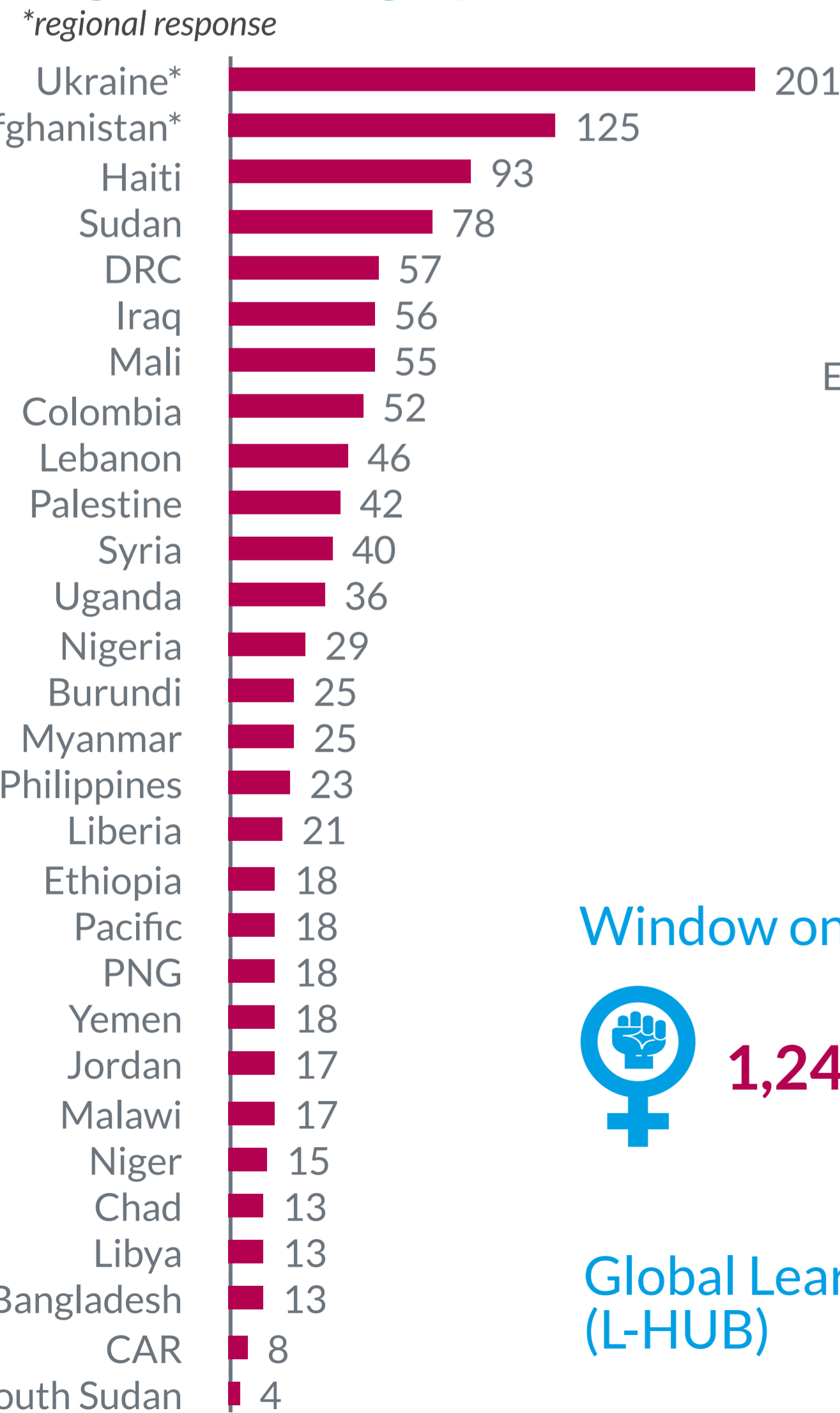
**Approved Grants by Outcome**



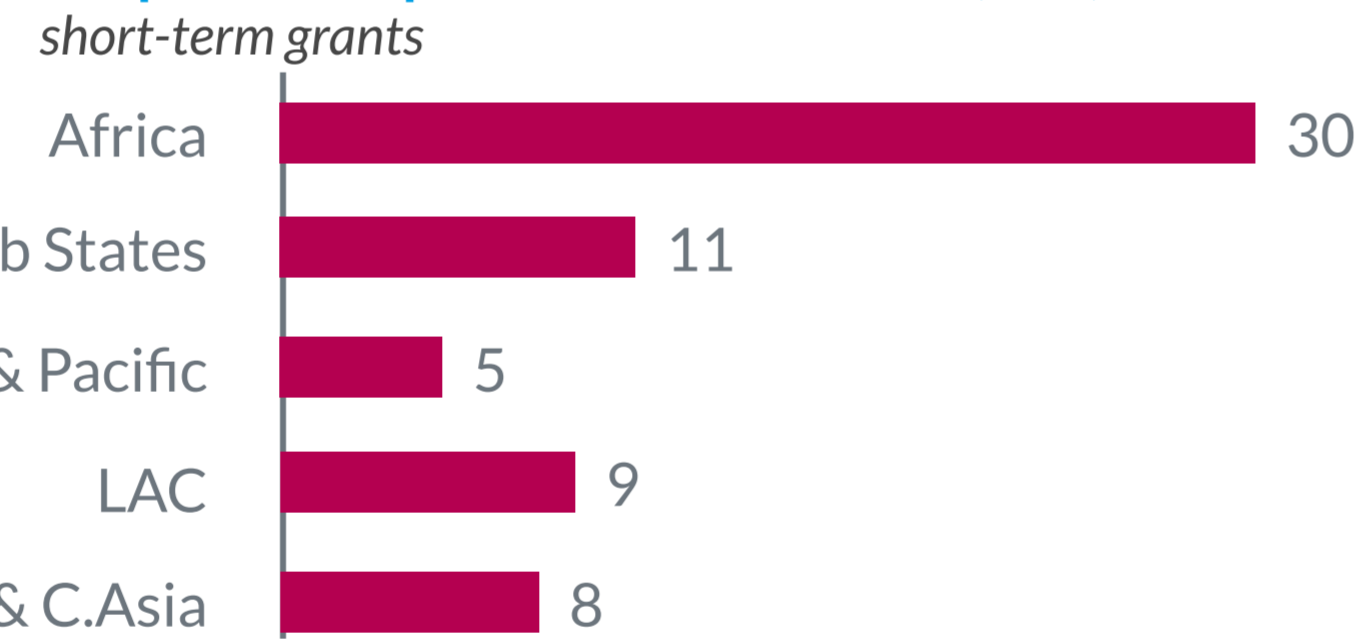
**CSOs Led by a Forcibly Displaced Person**

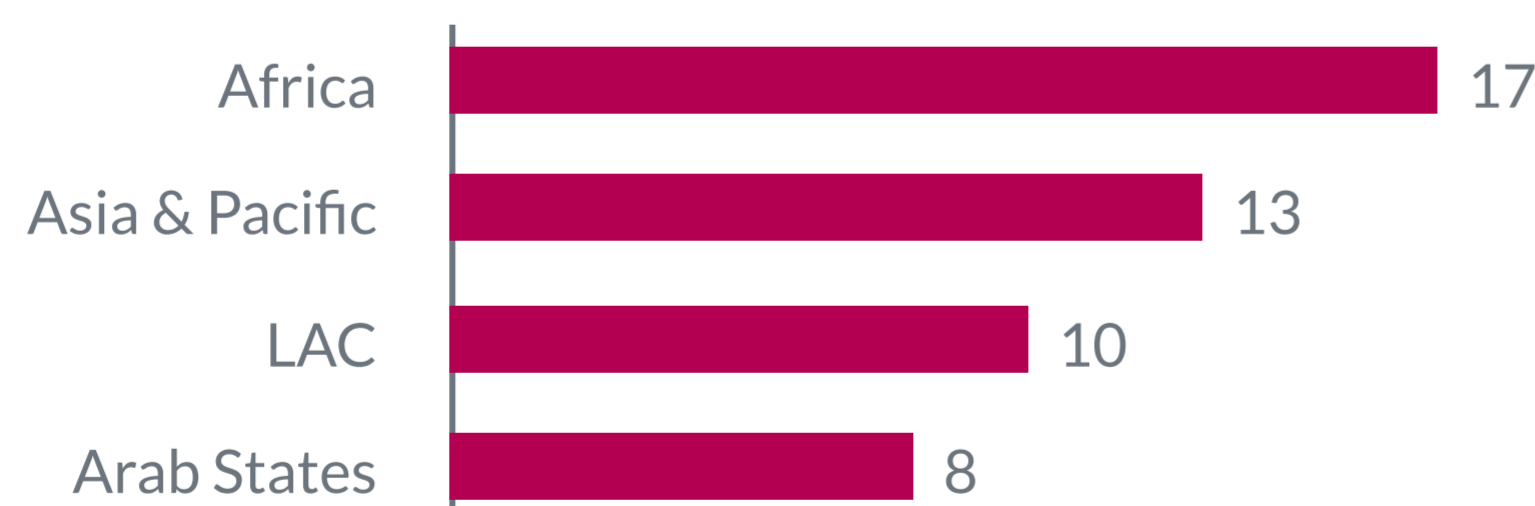
**Regular Funding Cycle (1,176)**

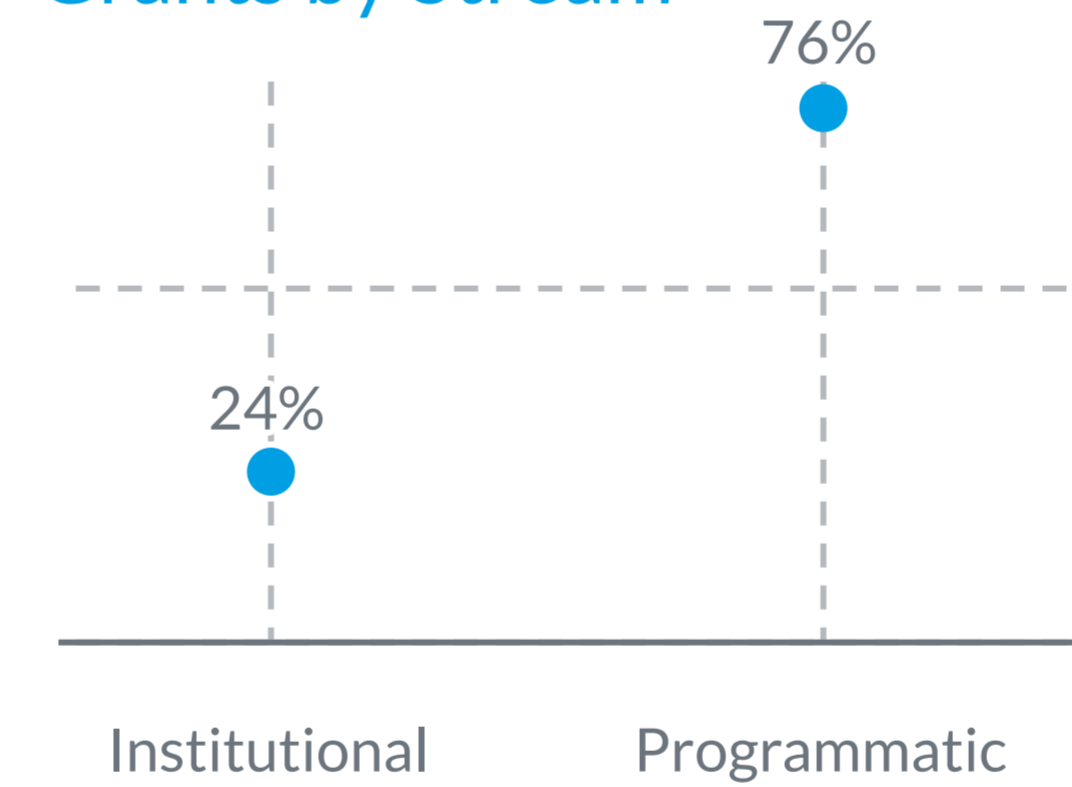

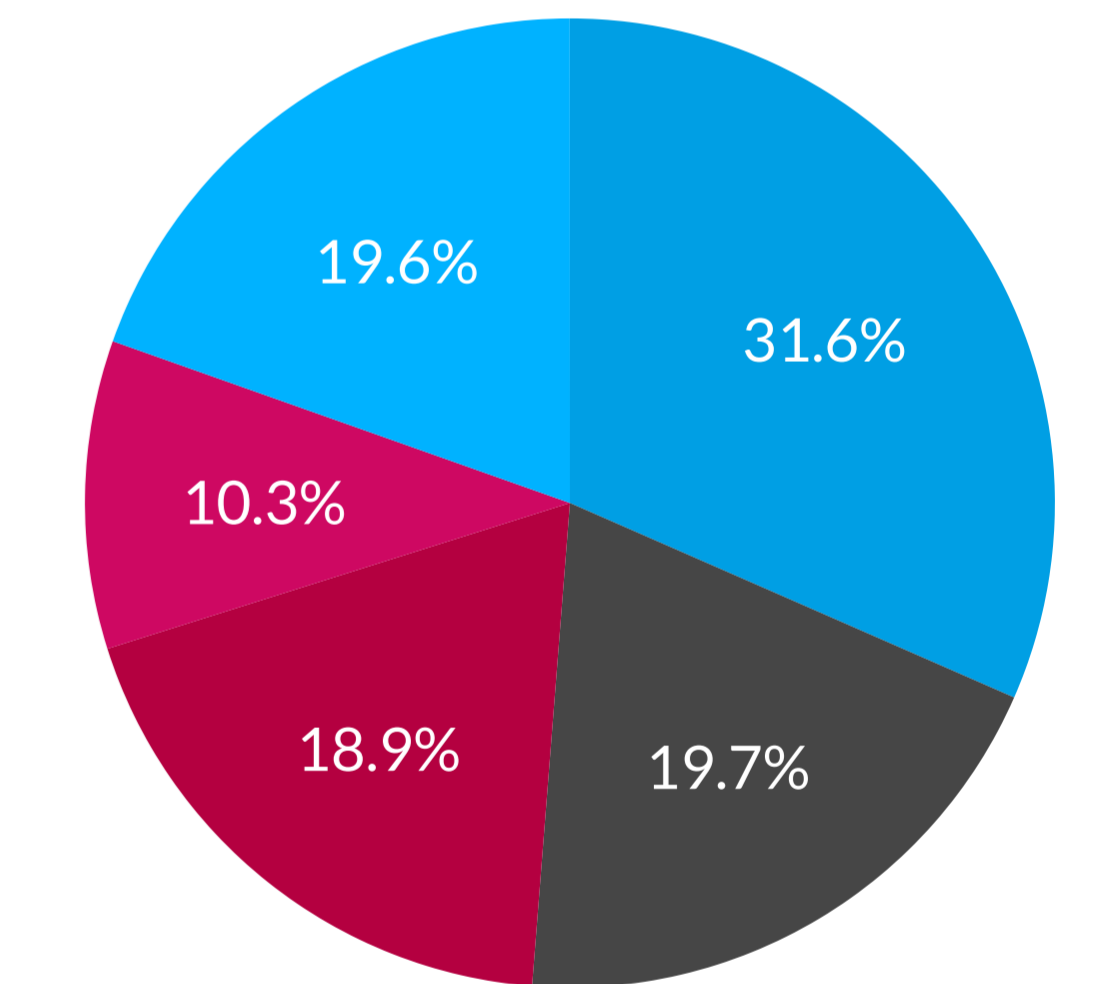
**Grants by Stream**



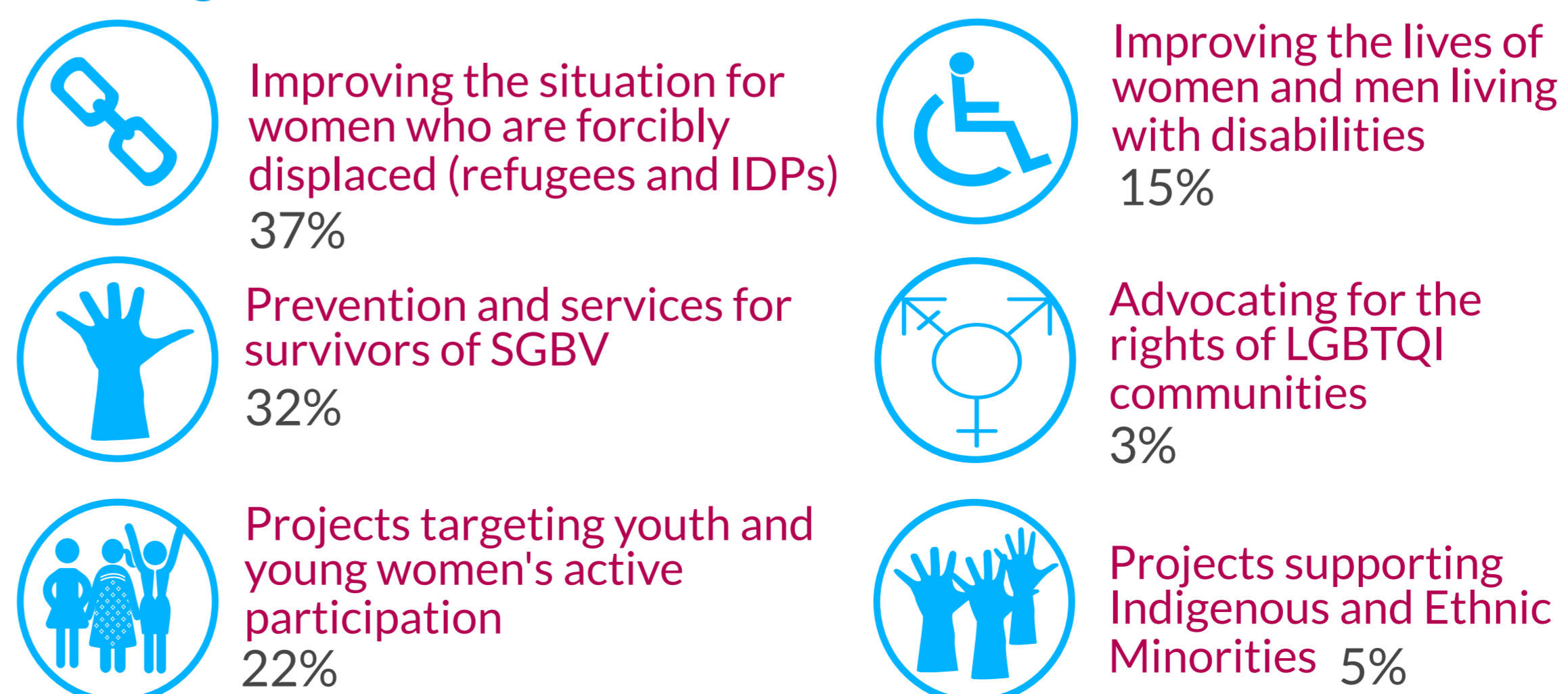
**Allocated Funds by Region**
