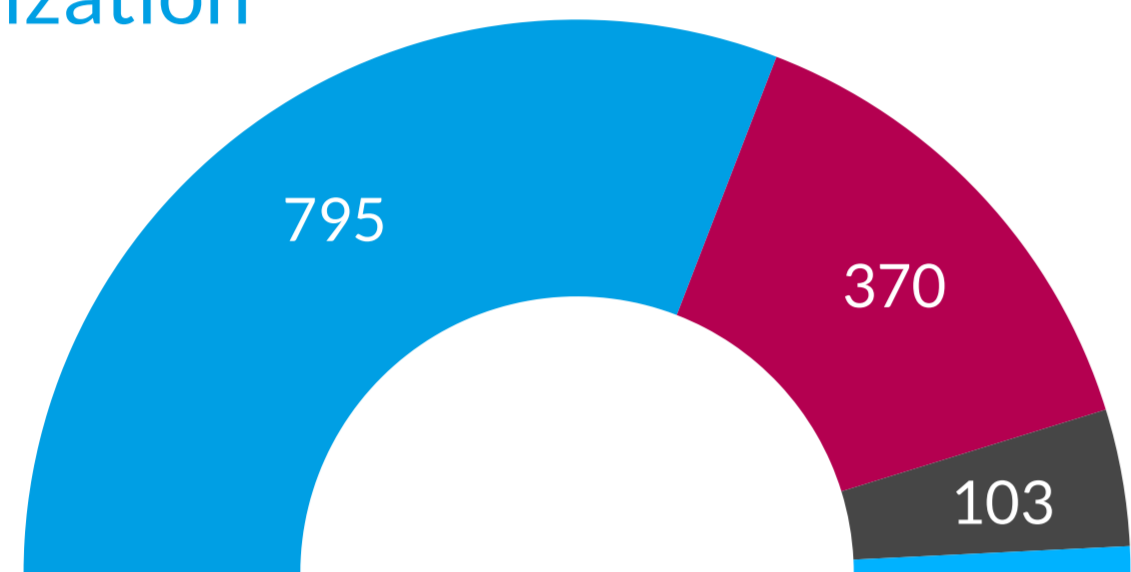


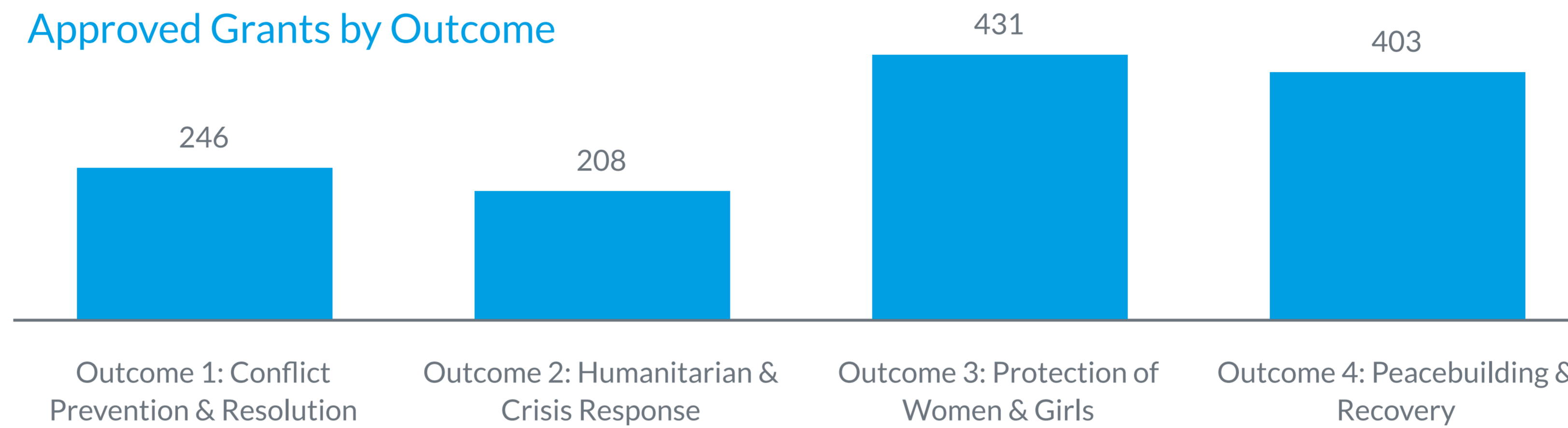

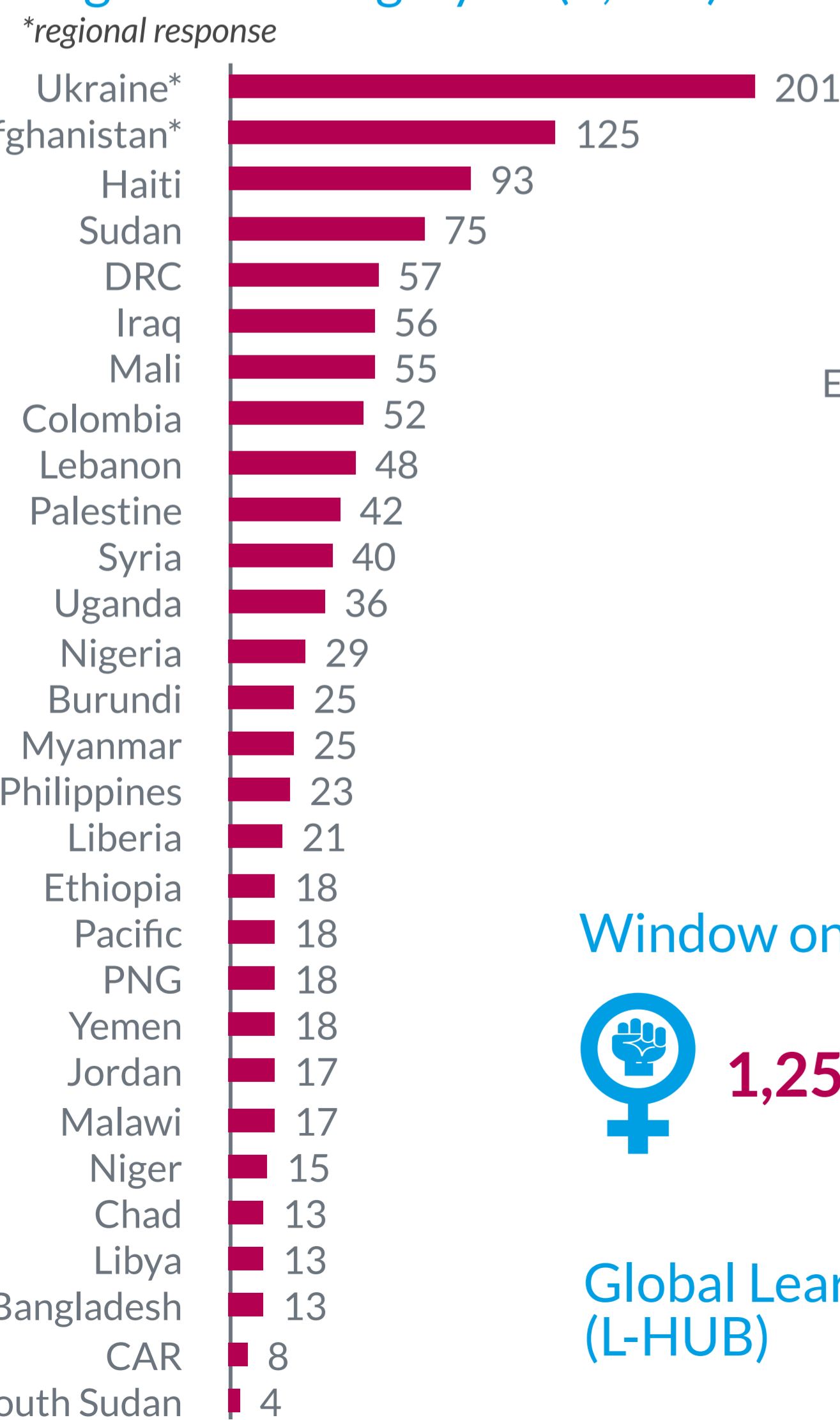
Approved Grants by Outcome



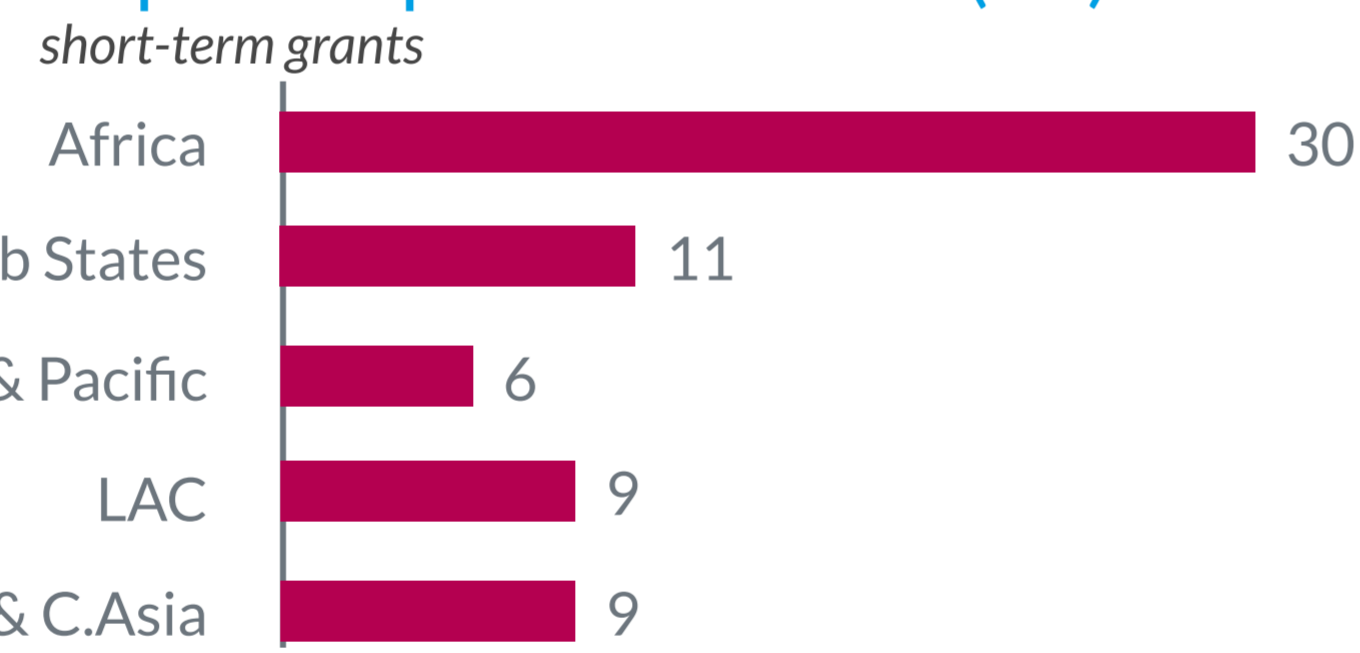
CSOs Led by a Forcibly Displaced Person

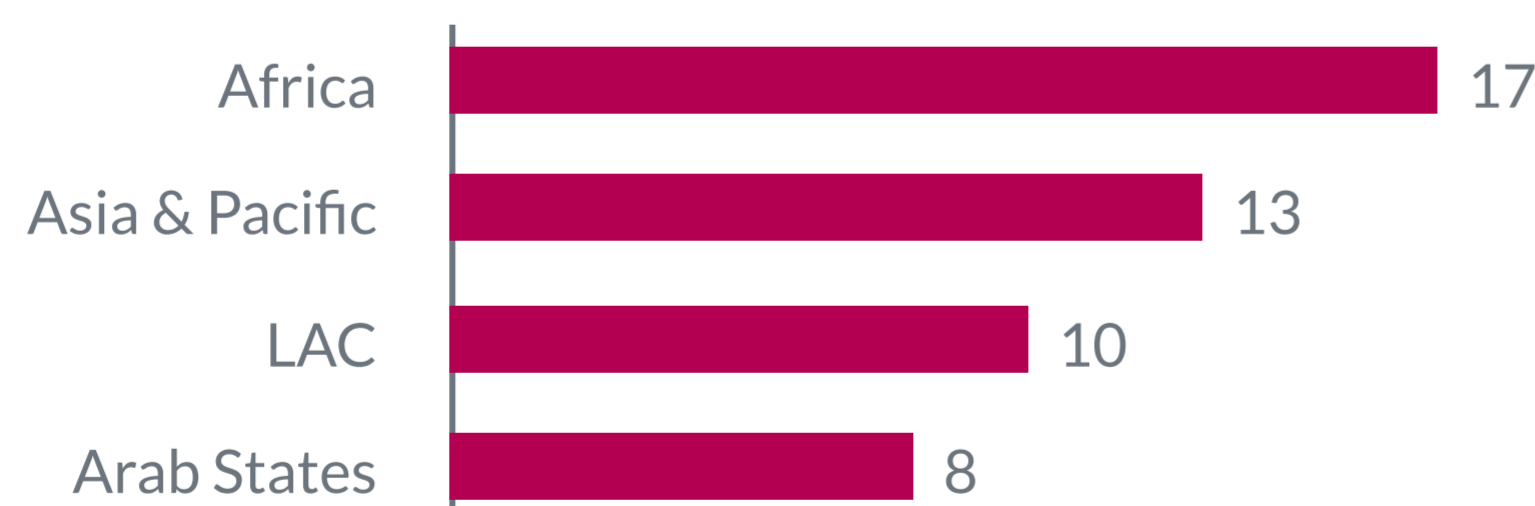
Regular Funding Cycle (1,175)

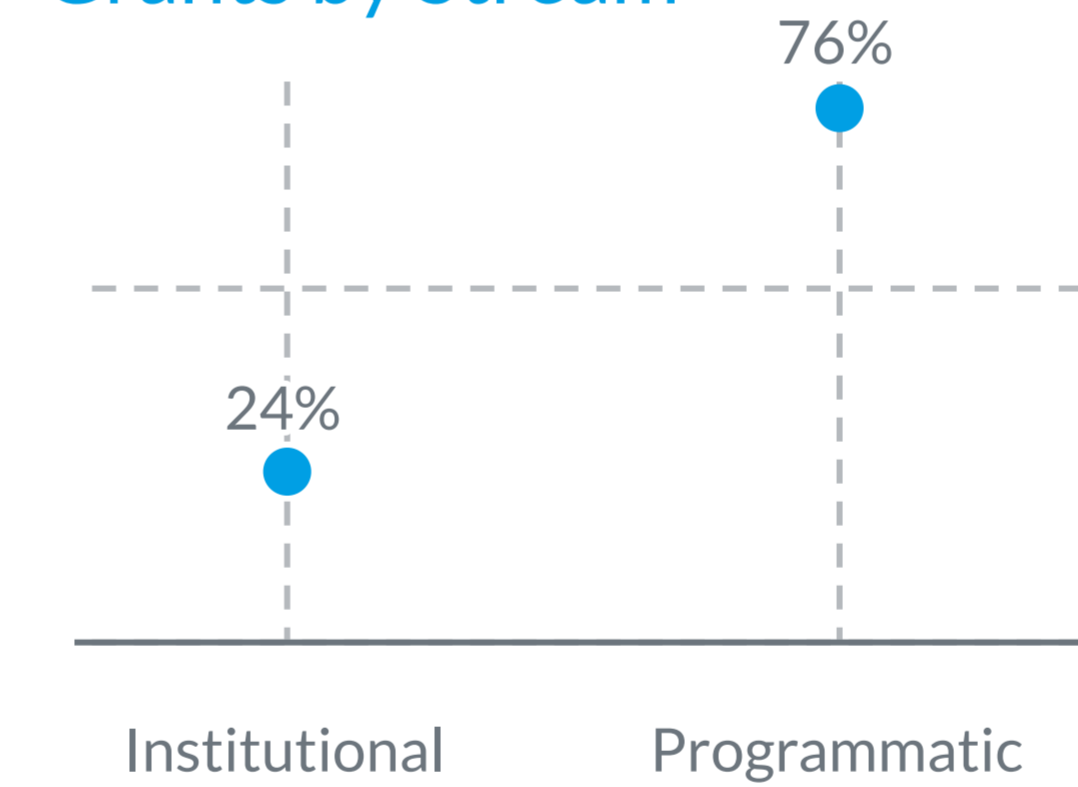

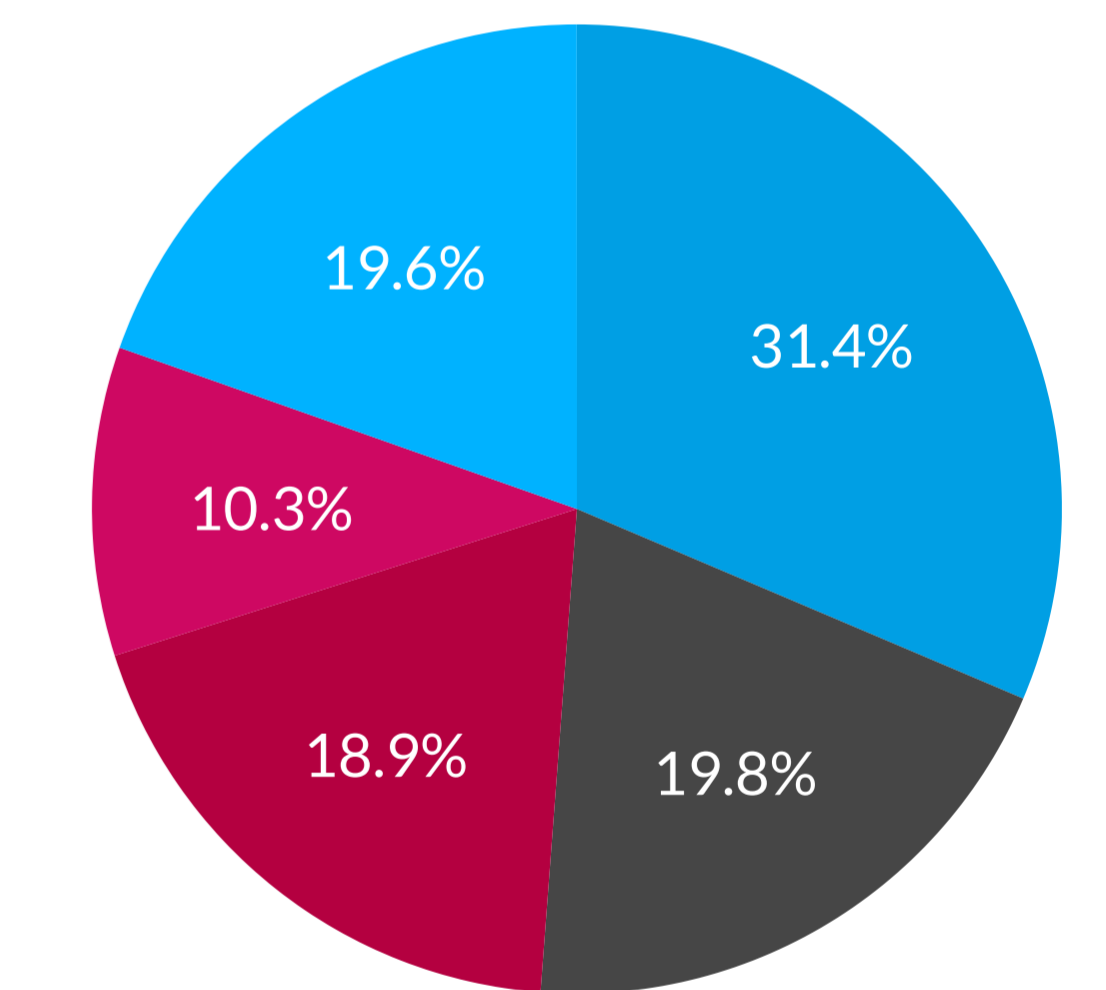

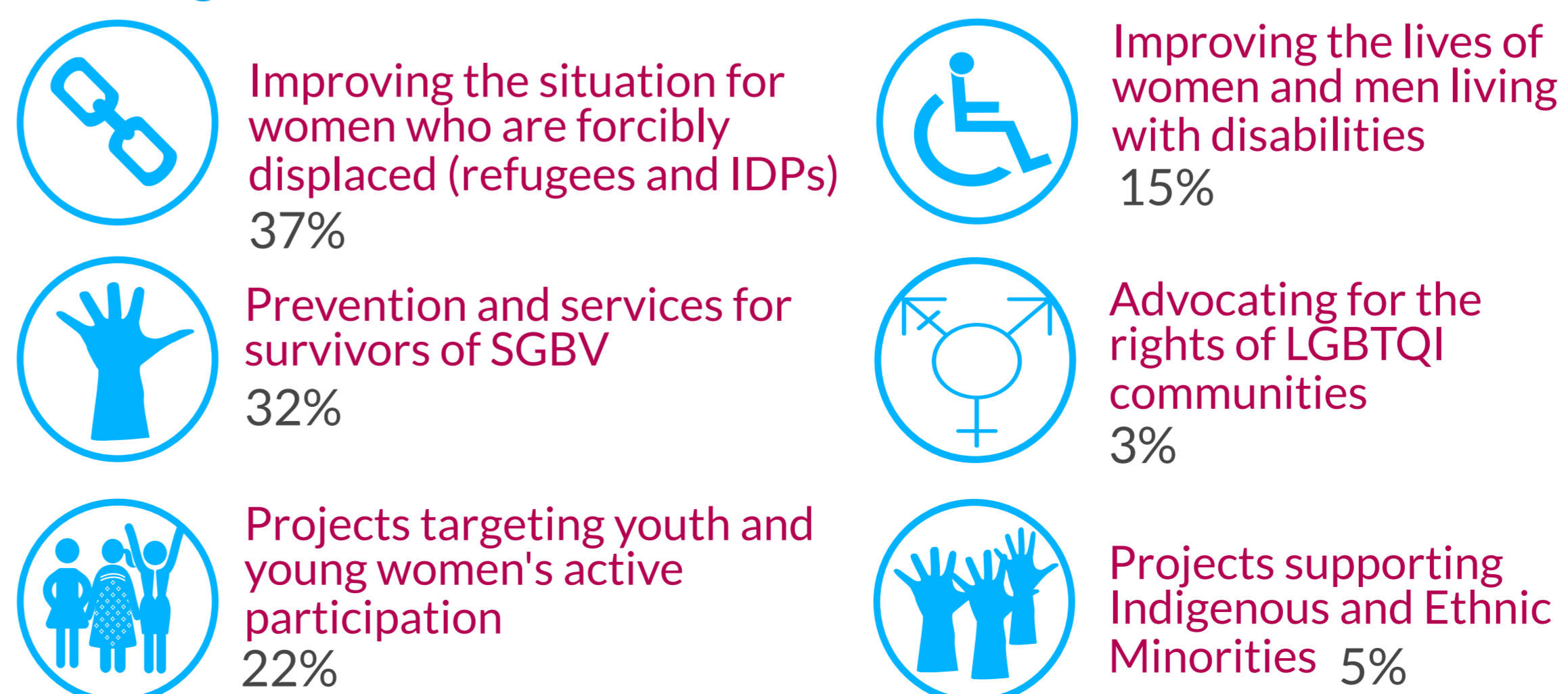
Grants by Stream
